On-site Registration/Check-In

Registration will be open on Friday, June 17th.

We will be forwarding detailed airline pickup information 2 weeks before the event. We expect all sailors to arrive at San Diego International Airport between **10 am and 4 pm** on Thursday August 11th. If you are driving please go directly to the Registration desk at MBYC (**Mission Bay Yacht Club ·1215 El Carmel Court, San Diego, CA 92109 - 858-488-0501)** between 1:00 PM and 6:00 PM Thursday August 11, 2016.

The registration team will confirm that all forms have been correctly submitted and information regarding the upcoming week will be distributed. <u>All</u> competitors' life jackets will be inspected at registration, as will harnesses for Club 420. Please refer to the NOR for PFD & harness requirements.

Housing assignments will be distributed upon completion of registration, but competitors will remain at MBYC through dinner. Charter boats will be assigned at the beginning of the Racing Clinic on Friday morning. After registration, the recreation areas of the club will be open until dinner is called, during which we will have several speakers. Host families will arrive to take competitors home immediately following the planned activities of the day.

EVENT ARRIVAL and DEPARTURE TIMES:

Early arrivals are not permitted – no exceptions. Being "Invited" by a MBYC member is *not* an exception to this rule. Violations will be dealt with strictly by the Organizing Committee and may be passed to the Protest Committee. All competitors should plan to arrive at **Mission Bay Yacht Club** between **1:00pm** and **6:00pm** on **Thursday, August 11th.**

Competitors may depart the event after the Awards Ceremony by car, with a parent or guardian, or on the airport van. Please indicate when you register how you will be departing. Information about cost will be provided no later than August 1. Please bring cash or credit card.

FOR YOUR OWN SAFETY, DO NOT ACCEPT RIDES OR TRANSPORTATION to or from Mission Bay Yacht Club that have not been pre-arranged by you or a member of your family.

AIRPORT INFORMATION:

WE WILL BE CONTACTING ALL SAILORS TRAVLEING BY AIR TO SAN DIEGO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT IN MID JULY WITH AIRPORT MEETING LOCATIONS. WE WILL ALSO PROVIDE EMAIL AND PHONE CONTACT INFORMATION FOR PEOPLE RESPONSIBLE FOR AIRPORT PICKUP.

ARRIVAL - US Sailing has negotiated a discount code from United Airlines for travel to the -2016 championships. This must be book directly through the US Sailing website. Go to http://www.ussailing.org/membership/benefits/. You cannot apply it either online or through a travel agent.

Competitors who use alternate airports will need to make their own arrangements for transportation to and from the event and ensure sufficient time to arrive and depart within the timeframes of the event. Departing flights should not be scheduled prior to 7:00 PM.



Competitors flying as Unaccompanied Minors or are 15 or under should contact the airline for special instructions and fees. You must ensure proper paper work is in place to allow the airline to release your child for pickup.

DEPARTURE - **Departure** for all competitors will be on Monday, August 15th following the awards ceremony. Flights should be scheduled for departure no earlier than 7:00pm on Monday. Requests for early or late departures must be made with National Chair Matthew Dubois (msdubois@sbcglobal.net) at least two weeks in advance. **Please DO NOT make flight arrangements outside these windows until the request has been approved.** Exceptions are approved in very rare circumstance. No event housing will be provided to competitors for Thursday night or later.

TRAVEL DELAYS, CHANGES OR QUESTIONS:

Any "day-of" questions regarding transportation on August 11th, should be directed to the MBYC transportation chair. We will provide this contact information in our Mid July transportation update. It is important that arrival and departure information be included as part of your registration.

If your plans change after the July 25th deadline, please e-mail the registrar, 2016juniorchampsregistrar@gmail.com

Changes in your travel schedule can be made prior to arrival but we ask that we receive all changes no later than July 29. Please be sure to go into your registration and update the information there as well.

DRIVING INSTRUCTIONS:

Local competitors may drive to MBYC for registration. The Drivers' Release must be completed on the Transportation Form and submitted with other required documents prior to arrival. No competitors' cars will be left at MBYC for the duration of the Junior Championships. Car keys will be held by MBYC and returned upon conclusion of the Awards Ceremony on Monday. There will be no driving of personal cars during the regatta. Offenders will be dealt with strictly.

MEDICAL FORM:

Each competitor must send a fully completed Medical Form along with all of the required waivers to 2016juniorchampsregistrar@gmail.com by July 25. Please attach a photocopy of the insurance card to the Medical Form. If any medical issues change after July 25, it is the responsibility of the parent/competitor to notify the regatta Registrar.

HOUSING:

<u>US Sailing Regulation 10.03</u> will be in effect from the moment a competitor arrives at the venue until he/she is home or at the airport. Offenders will be dealt with strictly as stated in the Notice of Race.

<u>All</u> competitors will be assigned to a host family at registration. Shortly after arrival at the host families' home, competitors are asked to share the host families' and event co-chairs' contact info with their parents. Please remember that these families have generously offered to have competitors as guests in their homes and please behave accordingly. A tidy, helpful, considerate, and thankful guest is always appreciated.

Transportation to and from the Yacht Club will be by walking or by the host family if not within walking distance. Attendance at all events is required.



MEALS:

Meals for each competitor will be provided throughout the regatta. A Continental Breakfast and Lunch Buffet will be served at the club each day. Dinners on Thursday, Saturday, and Sunday will be served at MBYC and Friday's dinner will be served at your host family's house. The awards ceremony will be Monday afternoon at MBYC upon the completion of boat pack-up. Please list dietary restrictions at online registration AND on the Medical Form.

PACK-UP

Failure to assist in the pack-up will result in forfeiture of \$250 of the damage deposit and may result in a competitor not receiving a charter at a future US Sailing event.

AWARDS CEREMONY

The awards ceremony is on Monday, August 15th. Attendance by competitors is **mandatory**. Competitors will not be allowed to leave before the Awards Ceremony and pack up of the boats without prior approval of the National Chair and will only be granted for extenuating circumstances. **Under no circumstances** will competitors be allowed to depart prior to the completion of the boat pack up.

CHARTER BOAT ASSIGNMENT:

Charter fees will be paid online by the stated deadline of July 26th. **Damage Deposit Forms and deposit must be returned with paperwork.** All boats will be provided fully equipped and no changes to the rigging, sheeting, blocks, or sails will be permitted. Doublehanded teams should bring their own bridle and harness.

Representatives from Zim Sailing and Vela will be on site at MBYC. Sears competitors will be expected to help prepare and rig their own boats each day and install the provided bow, hull and sail numbers following registration. It is the competitor's/team's responsibility to leave the charter boat in clean and good condition at the end of each day. Boats will be inspected each evening.

On Monday, August 15th all competitors will assist in the de-rigging, final check out and loading of charter boats for transport. Sailors will not be released to the Awards Dinner until all the boats have been checked in and loaded.

CREW CHANGES:

An Alternate is named on the entry form at the first level of competition, and may not be changed in the competitive year. Please refer to NOR 4.1-4.6. Crew changes will be granted only if there is a valid reason (see the <u>championship conditions</u> for specifics). Sailors who wish to change sailing partners must submit a request in writing confirming a legitimate reason.

Requests should be e-mailed to National Chair Matthew Dubois at msdubois@sbcglobal.net An Alternate should be provided to your Area Representative at the time of qualification. It is important to plan well in advance in an effort to retain original teams unless a true emergency arises.

RACING CLINIC:

Racing Clinics will be held at MBYC on Friday, August 12th from **8:00am – 6:30pm**. These clinics will cover charter boat assignment, rigging and handling of the boats, starts, local conditions, and practice races.

Participation in the clinics is mandatory. NO EXCEPTIONS



PRIVATE COACHES ARE NOT PERMITTED

RACING AREA:

ONLY FLAGGED SUPPORT BOATS WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE RACING AREA. No private support boats are permitted. Please review US Sailing's Spectator and Coach Boat policy and refer to NOR sections 18-19.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing Instructions will be distributed at registration and will be available on the championship's website http://www.ussailing.org/racing/championships/youth/juniorchamps/

GEAR:

Personal Flotation Device (life Jacket) - each competitor shall wear a USCG approved life jacket that is 100% dependent on foam for flotation and the appropriate size for the sailor, at all times while on the water, except for brief periods while adding or removing clothing.

A trapeze harness for Club 420 teams is mandatory. Hat, sunglasses, sunscreen and light weight sun protective rash guard are all highly recommended. Dress for dinner is clean and casual. Mark all personal belongings in advance – clothes, equipment, and gear.

WEATHER:

Weather information will be provided each race day on the official regatta bulletin board. Please see the following link for expected conditions in August in San Diego. https://weather.com/weather/today/I/USCA0982:1:US

ALCOHOL AND DRUGS:

No participant or competitor shall use or possess, either on or off the water: marijuana or any other substance if possession is illegal under state or federal law; or any alcoholic beverages (US Sailing Regulation 10).

An alleged breach of one of these regulations shall not be grounds for a protest. However, when the protest committee believes that a competitor may have breached one of these regulations, it shall follow the process described in the Championships Code of Conduct. If a competitor found to have breached one of the elements within the Code of Conduct, they shall be excluded from the remaining races of the series and, where practicable, removed from the regatta venue and sent home. The competitor's boat shall be disqualified from all races of the series.

CURFEW:

There will be a 10:00pm curfew during the event; meaning that ALL competitors must be "home" where they are being housed by 10:00pm each night. These regulations are in effect from Thursday, August 11th through Monday, August 15th.

COMPETITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR BRINGING THE FOLLOWING:

- Personal Flotation Device (life Jacket) each competitor shall wear a USCG approved life jacket that is 100% dependent on foam for flotation and the appropriate size for the sailor, at all times while on the water, except for brief periods while adding or removing clothing.
- Club 420 teams must bring a trapeze harness
- Compass/bracket



- Appropriate sailing gear and clothing for a range of weather conditions, particularly sun precaution
- Sunscreen, sunglasses and hat
- A water bottle- clearly labeled
- Notebook, pen,
- Appropriate attire for the awards dinner collared shirts, dresses or nice slacks

We, the undersigned participants hereby agree to charter from the Mission Bay Yacht Club one (1) Lightning sailboat (the "Boat") for the Chubb U.S. Junior Championships ("the Event") hosted by the Mission Bay Yacht Club ("the Host") on August 11-15, 2016.

We agree to be responsible for any damage or loss to the Boat unless responsibility is otherwise assigned by the protest committee.

In consideration of the Mission Bay Yacht Club chartering the boat, and to the extent that the insurance coverage of US Sailing and/or the Mission Bay Yacht Club is insufficient, we agree to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend the Boat's Owner(s), the Host and their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, owners, members, managers, employees, officers, directors, agents, representatives, successors and assigns from and against any and all claims, costs, expenses, or liability (including attorney's fees), attributable to bodily injury, sickness, disease, or death, or to damage or destruction of property (including loss of use of property) caused by, arising out of, resulting from, or occurring in connection with any activities we may engage in as a result of chartering the Boat.

- 1. No changes, additions, or alterations to the spars, sail, hull and fittings shall be made except as follows:
 - a) A compass, wind indicator and sail tell tales supplied by the competitor may be used provided that they can be fitted without piercing or otherwise marking the hull, spars or sail.
 - b) Plastic tape or similar may be used in accordance with the Class Rules.
- 2. Wet or dry sanding of the hulls or any other equipment is prohibited.
- 3. The use of waxes, polishing compounds or similar is prohibited.
- 4. No fitting may be removed, even if it is subsequently replaced, and no repairs may be undertaken without the permission of the US Sailing or the Mission Bay Yacht Club Representative.
- 5. The use of the charter boat may be withdrawn if, in the sole opinion of the US Sailing, or the Mission Bay Yacht Club, a competitor breaks any of the conditions of charter or treats or handles a charter boat without due care or in a manner which causes or is likely to do so.

We agree to maintain control of the Boat at all times, shall comply with the USCG International Navigation Rules, the Rules of the Organizing Authority, the Racing Rules of Sailing, and the Sailing Instructions of the Event. We agree that all persons on the Boat shall wear, while on the water, other than for brief periods while changing clothes, an adequate personal floatation device ("PFD"). See the Notice of Race for specifics. We further agree that if a representative of the Mission Bay Yacht Club or US Sailing notices one or more person(s) on the Boat without a PFD, such person(s) may be offered a ride off the Boat or the Boat may be instructed to return to the club immediately, and the Boat shall comply with such instructions irrespective of the status of the Event.

- 1. No changes, additions, or alterations to the spars, hull and fittings shall be made except as follows:
 - a. A compass and/or wind indicator supplied by the competitor may be used provided that they can be fitted without piercing or otherwise marking the hull, deck, or spars.
- 2. Wet or dry sanding of the hulls or any other equipment is prohibited.
- 3. The use of waxes, polishing compounds or similar is prohibited.

I have read and agree to the rental conditions outlined above.

- 4. Renting competitors may wash their boat with detergent and water.
- 5. Plastic tape or similar may be used in accordance with the Class Rules.
- 6. No fitting may be removed, even if subsequently replaced. All the fittings are sealed with silicon during manufacture.
- 7. No repairs may be undertaken without the written permission of the VELA LA LLC representative.
- 8. The use of the rental boat may be withdrawn if, in the sole opinion of the VELA LA LLC representative, a competitor breaks any of the conditions of rental or treats or handles a rental boat without due care or in a manner which causes or is likely to cause damage to the boat.
- 9. Any renting competitor found towing at more than 5kts will be charged \$500 and have the equipment withdrawn immediately.
- Boats, spars, cover and dolly will be supplied. Competitors must bring their own sail, blades, rigging, and tiller with extension.
- 11. Any damage or loss of equipment to a rental boat, no matter how slight, must be reported to the VELA LA LLC representative as soon as practicable.
- 12. The renting competitor and/or their guardian(s) are solely responsible for damage to boats or to other property. Any fault determined under the racing rules and all parties involved will be bound thereby, but shall have no consequence between the agreement of VELA LA LLC and the renting competitor. VELA LA LLC will recover all damages directly from the renting competitor. In the event of loss or theft, renting competitors will be charged the replacement value of the boat.
- 13. The credit card used to reserve and pay for the rental will also serve as the damage deposit. VELA LA LLC will only impose additional charges to the credit card for damage(s) incurred during the rental period. In the event of major damage, renting competitors will be charged the cost of the repair <u>plus</u> the depreciation of the boat.
- 14. Competitors are not covered or protected by VELA LA LLC or its insurance policy. Each renting party is responsible for providing their own valid third-party liability insurance coverage of at least US\$ 500,000.00 (or equivalent) per incident. Atfault damages to other boats are the responsibility of the renting competitor.
- 15. The renting competitor agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless owner, its employees, agents, officers and directors of VELA LA LLC from any and all liability for injury, loss or damage to third persons or the renting competitor, occasioned by the acts and conduct (whether due to negligence or otherwise) or default of renting competitor, or rental agents, representatives, employees or crew members, except to the extent any such liability is covered by owner's insurance.

No changes, additions, or alterations to the spars, sail, hull and fittings shall be made except for those permitted by class rules.

Damage: Persons chartering a boat will be held responsible for all damage, loss or theft to the dolly, the trailer, the boat, or the additional equipment that they have chartered, including blades, spars, sails or any other component thereof which was part of the charter. The boat and equipment chartered are new or like new and must be returned in the same condition as received, void of any tape or tape residue, hull numbers, scratches, salt and sand, or defacing markings. To this end, anyone chartering a boat must provide a valid credit card number and deposit before they may take delivery of any charter equipment. In the event of damage, loss or theft of any charter equipment or non-compliance to the charter agreement, the expense incurred in replacing or repairing of the damage will be charged to the charterer's credit card unless another method of payment is agreed upon.

Additional Considerations:

- 1. Wet or dry sanding of the hulls or any other equipment is prohibited.
- 2. The use of waxes, polishing compounds or similar is prohibited.
- 3. Competitors may wash their boat with detergent and water.
- 4. There will be no substitutions of rigging, blocks and any other equipment. Competitors must supply their own sails and trapeze harness. No hull or spar fittings may be removed, even if subsequently replaced. All fittings are sealed with silicon during manufacturing.
- 5. No repairs may be undertaken without the permission of the Organizing Committee and Zim Sailing Representative.
- 6. The use of the charter boat may be withdrawn if, in the sole opinion of the Zim Sailing Representative and the Organizing Committee, a competitor breaks any of the conditions of charter or treats or handles a charter boat without care or in a manner which causes or is likely to cause damage to the boat.
- 7. Any competitor found towing at more than 5kts will be charged \$500 and have the equipment withdrawn immediately.
- 8. No drilling or piercing of any part of the boat or equipment is permitted.
- 9. Tape residue, scuffs or any marks that can be removed without sanding or repair must be so removed at the end of the event by the competitor. The use of duct tape is prohibited.
- 10. All equipment (including hull/blades/spars) should be rinsed free of salt, sand or dirt incurred from the site. It is the responsibility of the competitor to return the equipment in an appropriate state.
- 11. Any damage or loss of equipment to a charter boat, no matter how slight, must be reported to the C420 representative at the completion of the race in which it occurs. The Zim representative is to be notified as soon as practical.
- 12. Responsibility for damage to boats or to other property will be determined under the racing rules and all contestants will be bound thereby.
- 13. Zim will charge a sailor's card ONLY if that sailor is to be charged for damage.
- 14. Competitors are not covered by any Zim insurance. It is recommended that competitors have their own coverage for personal property and liability insurance. At-fault damages to other boats are the responsibility of the skipper.

Introduction

Each competitor in a US Sailing Championship or Qualifier hereby pledges to uphold the spirit of this US Sailing Code of Conduct (Code). This Code is not intended to establish a set of rules that will, by inclusion or exclusion, prescribe the appropriate behavior for competitors in every aspect of their participation in a Championship or Qualifier. Rather, the Code offers general principles to guide the conduct of competitors in situations that have ethical implications.

The competitor commits to familiarization with this Code and understands that acceptance of its provisions is a condition of participation in a US Sailing Championship or Qualifier. Competitors who do not conform to this Code will be subject to the consequences of their actions, as specified below. The competitor has a right to a hearing if charged with a violation of this Code.

Elements of the Code

Each competitor in a US Sailing Championship pledges they:

Participation

> Will abide by The Racing Rules of Sailing, the US Sailing Regulations, all rules related to the Championship selection procedures as specified by US Sailing, the Championship Conditions, the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions for the Championship or Qualifier.

> Are eligible to compete under all US Sailing rules.

Fair Play and Conduct

Will abide by Rules 2 and 69 of the Racing Rules of Sailing.

Drugs & Alcohol

> Will abide by US Sailing Regulation 10.01.C for Prohibited Substances as defined below:

> For adult US Sailing championship events, no competitor shall use, either on or off the water: marijuana or any other controlled substance as defined by state or federal law.

> For Junior and Youth events or for junior or youth competitors in any US Sailing championship, no participant or competitor shall use, either on or off the water, marijuana or any other controlled substance, or alcoholic beverages as defined by state or federal law.

Sexual Abuse & Harassment

Will abide by US Sailing Regulation 13.04 for Sexual Abuse & Harassment.

Physical Abuse & Assault

Will abide by US Sailing Regulation 13.05 for Physical Abuse & Assault

Bullying & Hazing

Will abide by US Sailing Regulation 13.06 for Bullying & Hazing.

Enforcement of the Code

> Compliance with this Code depends primarily upon understanding and voluntary compliance, secondarily upon reinforcement by peers, and, when necessary, upon enforcement through disciplinary action.

> If a competitor has been alleged to have violated this Code, the competitor will be given two options:

Voluntarily withdraw from the Championship or Qualifier where the violation occurred. The competitor shall be scored RET in all races sailed and not sailed. A report will be sent to US Sailing. If the offense warrants, further action will be taken pursuant to Rule 69

or

A hearing will be held and if the Code is determined to have been broken, the hearing panel has the authority to remove the athlete from the venue immediately and mark all races as DSQ. Further action may be taken if needed pursuant to Rule 69.

> Before making a decision whether to withdraw from the Championship or Qualifier, or to request a hearing, the competitor will be given the opportunity to consult with an individual of their choice before racing commences, in order to better understand their options and potential outcomes.
