NOTICE OF RACE

This Wianno Senior Regatta organizing authority is the Stone Horse Yacht Club.

- Rules -The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016 (RRS). For the
 purposes of the definition of rule, the class rules shall be the rules of the Wianno Senior class. Rules may be changed
 and these changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions, or as amendments to the Sailing Instructions (See
 Section 5 of this Notice)
- Eligibility and Entry -This regatta is open to all Wianno Seniors. Competitors may register online via the Stone
 Horse Yacht Club/Regatta Network website. Competitors may also register at Check-in/Arrival on July 30, 2016 at
 the Stone Horse Yacht Club

- 4. Liability- Each Skipper accepts full responsibility and liability. Neither the Stone Horse Yacht Club nor its Governors, Officers, Employees, Race Committee, members or any other individual or entity affiliated with this regatta shall be held responsible to any participating boat owner, skipper, crew, or their families, heirs or assigns. See RRS 4 Decision to Race.
- 5. Sailing Instructions-Sailing instructions will be available at the Wianno Senior website, SHYC Regatta Network website, and at the SHYC Clubhouse on Saturday, July 30. Any amendments to the sailing instructions will be posted on the notice board in the SHYC clubhouse prior to the 1130 on July 30, 2016.
- Race area and Courses-Race area will be ½ mile southwest of the Wychmere harbor breakwater. Courses will be delineated in the Sailing Instructions.
- 7. Alternative Penalty-360 Degree Penalty turn is in effect. This requires that infringing boat to conduct one gybe and one tack in the same direction as per the Wianno Senior Class Rules. This modifies Rules 44.1 and 44.2 of the RRS
- 8. Scoring-Scoring is determined by the "Cox-Sprague" scoring system with no drops.
- 9. Support Boats All support boats must stay clear of the race course at all times, and must follow any instructions of the Race Committee or designated patrol boats.
- 10.
