# NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

- 1.1 This race will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 60, 63.2 and 63.4 shall not apply.
- 1.3 US Sailing Prescriptions to Appendix T, Sections A and C shall apply.
- 1.4 To the extent allowed under RRS 87, class rules are changed to allow the use of VHF radios and GPS.
- 1.5 RRS 63.7 shall be changed to read "If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the later shall apply.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- 2.1 This event is open to all One Design, Spinnaker and JAM mono-hull boats whose owners are members of the Edgewater Yacht Club or other Inter-Lake Yachting Association clubs.
- 2.2 The deadline for registration is 1000 hrs. on July 4, 2016. Eligible yachts shall register on-line at <a href="http://www.regattanetwork.com">http://www.regattanetwork.com</a>.

# 3. FEES

3.1 The entry fee is \$10.00.

# 4. SCHEDULE of EVENTS

- 4.1 Friday, July 4, 2016
  - 1100 hrs.: Mandatory Skippers' Meeting (EYC Main Room or Patio).
  - 1200 hrs.: First start Signal. After the first start, all boats shall start at their assigned times.

#### 5. MEASUREMENT

- 5.1 All One Design boats shall conform to their class rules.
- 5.2 All Spinnaker and JAM boats are strongly encouraged to have a PHRF certificate and race under those rules.
- 5.3 Any boat without a valid measurement certificate shall have a temporary rating assigned by the Organizing Authority (OA) whose decision is final, without appeal and not subject redress.

# 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS and VENUE

- 6.1 A "Pursuit Start" will be used.
- 6.2 The race area shall be the near shore area North of Edgewater Yacht Club.
- 6.3 Sailing Instructions, Course and Start Times shall be available at the Skippers' Meeting.

# 7. SCORING

7.1 Scoring shall be in accordance with the low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A.

# 8. AWARDS

8.1 Prizes shall be awarded for the top (three) finishers. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA.

# 9. DISCLAIMER of LIABILITY

- 9.1 Sailing is an activity that has inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- 9.2 The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, Edgewater Yacht Club, sponsors or any other organization or official) shall not be responsible for damage to any Boat or other property or the injury, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitors participation in this event to the fullest extent of the law.

# 10. INSURANCE

- 10.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid, third party insurance, sufficient to cover Liability for loss, damage, personal injury or death with a minimum value of \$100,000.00.
- 10.2 Each boat shall file evidence of current insurance the Edgewater Yacht Club office.
