THE F W ROBERTS TROPHY WAS HAND-GIFTED BY COMMODORE F. W. ROBERTS TO THE CLEVELAND YACHTING CLUB IN 1930 AND IS AWARDED TO THE WINNER OF THE PHRF FLEET IN THE ANNUAL RACE. THE RACE HAS BEEN RUN IN SEVERAL FORMATS, MOST RECENTLY FROM CLEVELAND TO HURON AND BACK.

F W ROBERTS MEMORIAL CHALLENGE

THE F W ROBERTS MEMORIAL, WHICH WAS GIFTED TO THE CLEVELAND YACHTING CLUB IN MEMORIAM OF THE LATE F. W. ROBERTS, HAS BEEN AWARDED TO THE WINNER OF THE AUXILIARY FLEET IN THE RACE.

ELIGIBILITY

ALL BOATS WITH VALID AND CURRENT *PHRF-LE RACING CERTIFICATES*, OR RECOGNIZED CERTIFICATES, ARE WELCOME TO PARTICIPATE. PLEASE REFER TO THE *RACING RULES OF SAILING* AND *SAILING INSTRUCTIONS* FOR FURTHER DETAILS.

TROPHIES

AWARDS WILL BE GIVEN OUT FOR FIRST, SECOND, AND THIRD PLACE WINNER IN EACH FLEET. THE WINNER OF THE PHRF FLEET (COURSE A) WILL BE DESIGNATED THE WINNER OF THE F W ROBERTS TROPHY AND WILL HAVE THEIR NAME INSCRIBED ON THE PERPETUAL AWARD AND PROMINENTLY DISPLAYED IN THE CLEVELAND YACHTING CLUB CLUBHOUSE. THE WINNER OF THE AUXILIARY FLEET (COURSE B) WILL BE DESIGNATED THE WINNER OF THE F W ROBERTS MEMORIAL CHALLENGE AND WILL HAVE THEIR NAME INSCRIBED ON THE PERPETUAL AWARD AND PROMINENTLY DISPLAYED IN THE CLEVELAND YACHTING CLUB CLUBHOUSE.

PHRF COURSE – COURSE A

START: Between CYC Race Committee boat and CYC S MARK, Leaving S Mark to Port

MARK 1 Will be CYC D Mark Leaving D Mark to Port

MARK 2 will be the Cleveland Water Intake Crib, left to Port

MARK 3 will be Lorain Harbor Outer Break Wall, left to Port.

FINISH between CYC S Mark and inflatable Finish Mark, leaving CYC S Mark to Starboard.

DISTANCE: 41 Nautical Miles

JAM COURSE: COURSE B

Primary Course:

START between CYC Race Committee Boat and CYC S Mark Leaving S Mark to Port

MARK 1, Will be CYC D Mark Leaving D Mark to Port

MARK 2, Will be CYC B Mark Leaving B Mark to Port

MARK 3, Will be CYC F Mark Leaving F Mark to Port

Mark 3 will be Lorain Harbor Outer Break Wall, left to Port.

FINISH between CYC S Mark and inflatable Finish Mark, leaving CYC S Mark to Starboard.

DISTANCE: 35 Nautical Miles

CYC S Mark (RR break wall to S = 350 deg) 41° 30.96' 81° 50.92'

CYC A mark (S to A = 345 deg) 41° 31.78' 81° 51.38'

CYC B mark (S to B = 30 deg) 41° 31.78' 81° 50.46'

CYC C mark (S to C = 75 deg) 41° 31.30' 81° 49.83'

CYC D mark (S to D = 120 deg) 41° 30.63' 81° 49.83'

CYC E mark (S to E = 165 deg) 41° 30.18' 81° 50.46'

CYC F mark (S to F = 210 deg) 41° 30.18' 81° 51.38'

CYC G mark (S to G = 255 deg) 41° 30.63' 81° 52.00'

CYC H mark (S to H = 300 deg) 41° 31.30' 81° 52.00'

Cleveland Water Intake Crib 41° 33.00' 81° 45.00'

Lorain Lighthouse 41° 28.90' 82° 11.70'

** Waypoints are approximate. Avon Point passing point is approximate – Shallows and underwater obstructions exist.
