2016 Boardman's Challenge

1. **RULES:** Each log canoe that is an active member of the CBLSCA can offer up one team of 4 boardman to represent their canoe. Only those 4 boardmen will compete in the events.

You are required to bring one board from your canoe.

2. **ELIGIBILITY:** To be considered a boardman, you must:
 - A. Have raced at least 20% of the races in the last year on the canoe you are representing
 - B. Have not trimmed a jib, fore, or main in the last 2 years
 - C. Have never skippered a canoe

We expect that participants are standard crew onboard the canoe in either a primary boardman, inside boardman, squelchie, or bailer position.

If there is some question if a participant actually meets the requirements, we will defer to the skipper of the canoe in question as to the qualification of the participant.

3. **REGISTRATION:** We will want to know the names of each representative participant for each canoe. You can also tell us a nickname, if you like. Register online here:

4. **REGISTRATION FEE:** None – but bring your board and a bailer bucket

5. **SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**

6. **EVENTS:** There will be a series of events to test the skill of the boardmen. These events will test strength, agility, swimming with your board, and bailing your boat. You will get wet. Be prepared to be wet.
7. **BOARDMAN INSTRUCTIONS:** Boardman Instructions will be provided at Registration.
8. **EVENT AREA:** The events will be held in the field and the pool at the Miles River Yacht Club.
9. **SCORING:** The low point scoring system of Appendix A (RRS) will apply. One completed event constitutes a series. There will be a tie-breaker event if necessary.
9. **TROPHIES:** Trophies will be awarded to the first, second, and third place teams. Additional trophies may be awarded.
10. **SOCIAL:** This event is about 80% social. Bring all your crew and friends – everyone is welcome. A bar will be set up at the pool for purchasing beverages. Please don't bring alcohol on the Club grounds. We might have some snacks and other items too. Because it is a race weekend, the Club is open for normal food and beverage service.
