NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authorities: Hobie Fleet 80, 132 Cheshire Road, Daytona Beach, FL, 32118

1 Rules

This regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (2013-2016).

2 Eligibility and Entry

2.1 Open to all multihulls over 15ft LOA with a valid US Sailing Portsmouth rating.

2.2 Registration will be on site the morning of competition.

2.3 Any modifications a competitor has made to a boat that violates its class's rules must make note of the modification on the registration application. The boat's base rating will be revised using the correction factors specified in the MH Modifications Table of the US Sailing Portsmouth Yardstick.

2.4 The race committee reserves the right to penalize or disqualify boats that do not comply to items 3.3.

3 Notices to Competitors

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board, the location of which will be announced at the Competitors' Meeting.

4 Fees

\$65 per boat, payable in-person at registration.

6 Regatta Site

6.1 The regatta will take place at Perry's Ocean Resort (2209 South. Atlantic Ave, Daytona Beach, 32118). Registration and the skippers meeting will take place near the tiki bar.

6.2 Boats will be launched directly off the beach into the surf.

6.3 IMPORTANT – Boats may be left on the beach overnight. However the hulls must be pointing east or west and the cat tracks cannot lie on the sand. Cars and trailers must be off the beach by 7:00PM each night. Overnight trailer parking can be found on the west side of A1A, just south of the 7-11 across the street from Perry's.

7 Venue and Course

7.1 The venue will be the Atlantic Ocean.

7.2 The race course will be a single loop. Starting at Perry's and heading north to the turning mark at the Main St Pier. Then south to the R2 bell buoy at Ponce Inlet. Then returning north to the finish at Perry's. Approximate distance is 24 nm.

8 Scoring

There will only be one race. Each boat's elapsed time will be corrected according to its Portsmouth rating.

9 Prizes

1st Overall

1st – 3rd Overall Corrected

Three-hour-tour Award (longest elapsed time)

Shipwreck Award (most notable catastrophe)

10 Disclaimer of Liability

All competitors will be required to sign a waiver of liability as a condition of entry. Parents/guardians must sign for competitors under 18.
