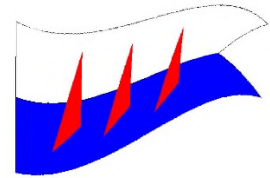

NOTICE OF RACE

2016 Holder 20 National Championships

Oct 21-23, 2016



Organizing Authority: The Holder 20 National Championships is organized by the Holder 20 Class Association in conjunction with the Concord Yacht Club.

Rules: The Regatta will be governed by the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing and the US Sailing Prescriptions as modified by the Sailing Instructions. This will include RRS 77 covering sail numbers.

Eligibility: This is an open regatta for Holder 20 sailboats that conform to the Class One Design rules.

Important Note: This regatta will be held in conjunction with the Concord Yacht Club's annual Fall Regatta (Sat/Sun only). The Holder 20 fleet will have their own start and possibly their own course at the discretion of the Principle Race Officer.

Registration: Registration fees are \$75 if paid on or before Sept 30, \$90 on or after Oct 1. No entries will be accepted after 1100 Friday, October 21, 2016. Registration includes one Friday dinner, one Saturday dinner and one tee-shirt. Extra meals, bag lunches and tee-shirts can be had for an additional fee. Registrations are handled through the Regatta Network.

Schedule: Thursday night welcome. Friday, competitors meeting 11am, racing starting at 1pm, dinner and party in the evening. Saturday, racing starting at 11am, dinner and party in the evening. Sunday racing starting at 11am, no races started after 2pm, awards immediately after racing.

Courses: Races will be sailed on Fort Loudoun Lake in the vicinity of Concord Yacht Club. Courses will be windward-leeward, with lengths at the discretion of the PRO. Full details will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

Scoring/Prizes: Scoring will be based on the low point system, with one discard if 7 or more races are sailed. Prizes will be awarded to the top five places.

Facilities: The local Farragut TN community offers a large variety of hotel accommodations and restaurants. Concord Yacht Club offers large grounds with launch ramps, clubhouse with kitchen, camping and bath-house facilities, child-friendly beach and playground. Weather at this time of year typically has overnight lows of 45F and daytime highs of 75F. Surface water temperatures are approximately 70F.

Charter boats/crew: Some local boats may be available for charter. A local crew bank, including the local University of Tennessee Sailing Club may also be available. Contact Regatta Registrar Don Busby for details (don@countryplacesinc.com).
