1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. 1.2 All boats shall have a VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on VHF channels 06 and 16.

1.3 If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions take precedence. This changes rule 63.7

1.4 All boats shall carry the required safety equipment conforming to government regulations that apply in the racing area.

2. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority (OA) for this regatta will be PHRF-MA.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 This regatta is open to all 18 foot and above mono-hull boats with a VALID 2016 PHRF-MA certificate.

3.3 Fleets will be divided into Non-Spin and Spin and may have multiple divisions depending on the amount entries. There will be 2 starts Non-spin and Spin

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND DIVISION ASSIGNMENT

6.1 Sailing Instructions will be available the competitors briefing Friday 10 September2016 @ 1900 Hours Toms River Yacht Club6.2 Classes will be determined by a yacht's PHRF rating and made by the OA.

7. COURSES

The distance course will be a combination of fixed and drop marks as described in the Sailing. The total length of the course may be dependent upon the day of race forecast and racing conditions.

8. PROTEST

8.1 All protests and requests for redress must be filed in writing at TRYC with the Protest Committee within 30 minutes of the last yacht to finish. This changes rule 61.3.8.2 Rule 61. 1(a) is modified in that a yacht intending to protest a yacht for a rule of Part 2, shall notify the Race Committee via VHF channel 06 and receive acknowledgment from the Race Committee, at the finish line, giving the name and sail number of the yacht being protested.
