Notice of Race

Rules

The regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing, the Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race.

These are the two GBCA races that count with the LYC Heald Bank (4/29-30/16) and HYC Offshore (5/6-7/16) races for scoring the Texas Navy Cup for Spinnaker boats and S. Rhoads Fischer Cup for Non-Spinnaker boats. Participants must register and compete in all four races to be in competition for these offshore racing awards.

Eligibility

This regatta is open to all seaworthy yachts suitable for offshore cruising or racing along the Texas Gulf Coast. All yachts shall have either a valid PHRF-GB certificate or be entered in the GBCA Cruising Class, or shall have formed a one design class and supplied a set of class rules, subject to the discretion of the race committee. A minimum of three boats is required to form a class. Expected classes are PHRF-Spinnaker, PHRF-Non-Spinnaker and GBCA Cruising Club. Classes which have formed by 1700 hours Wednesday, September 14, 2016 will be awarded trophies as follows:

- 3 boats: 1 place
- 4-6 boats: 1, 2 place
 7-9 boats: 1, 2, 3 place
- 10 or more boats: 1, 2, 3, 4 place

Entries

Competitors may enter online at: https://www.regattanetwork.com/clubmgmt/applet_club_events.php?CLUB_ID=162. PHRF certificates may be uploaded at the time of registration (preferred), or delivered to the competitors briefing. The entry fee will be: \$100.00 if registered and paid before September 16, 2016. Current members of US Sailing will receive a \$10.00 discount. Entry fees will be refunded if the entry is withdrawn prior to the entry deadline. The deadline for all entries is Friday, September 23, 2016 at 1900 CST; however, entries received after 2359 CST, Wednesday, September 14, 2016 will be subject to a \$25.00 late fee. Each entry includes two event passes. Additional passes will be available for \$25.

Boats intending to race in a handicap fleet other than GBCA Club Handicap must have delivered a current PHRF-GB rating certificate to the Race Committee or uploaded it to Regatta Network before the conclusion of the competitors briefing.

Courses

Offshore courses around fixed rig and dropped tetrahedron marks between Bolivar Roads, Galveston Jetties and the Gulf of Mexico. This is a two day regatta, with two offshore races planned. All races will start from the Galveston Jetty / Bolivar Roads Marker #11, and will race to designated offshore rig(s) and back.
