1. RULES

- 1.1. The event will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- 1.1.1. RRS 77 and Appendix G are changed in that the only requirement is that sail numbers be unique and legible.
- 1.2. The event will also be governed by the Class rules published by the national class association of each class.
- 1.2.1. Class rules are changed, as membership in a national class association is not required.
- 1.3. All rule changes will be identified in the sailing instructions.
- 1.4. Preliminary Sailing Instructions will be available at www.miamiyachtclub.net. Final Sailing Instructions will be Available at packet pick up

2. CLASSES

- 2.1. Optimist Red, White, & Blue
- 2.2. Optimist Green
- 2.3. Open Bic, Techno 293, Kona 1, RSX
- 2.4. Other classes, depending on interest, could include Laser, 420, Beach cats, or others

3. COURSES

Depending on registration it is expected that three courses will be managed.

- 3.1. Optimist Red, White & Blue North of Venetian Causeway (West side of area)
- 3.2. Optimist Green, Open Bic East of the Miami Yacht Club
- 3.3. Other classes North of Venetian Causeway (East side of area)

4. ADVERTISING

4.1. Advertising will be restricted to ISAF Category A, unless modified by class rules to Category C.

5. ELIGIBILITY

- 5.1. All competitors must be at least one of the following:
- 5.1.1. Member of US Sailing.
- 5.1.2. Member of a Yacht Club (YC) recognized by US SAILING.
- 5.1.3. Member of a Community Sailing Program, which is recognized by US SAILING.

7. REGISTRATION

- 7.1. Registrations must be received by December 5th, 6:00PM. No registrations accepted on day of race.
- 7.2. Competitors must register in advance ONLINE or by mailing / or dropping by the completed entry form and entry fees to the Miami Yacht Club.
- 7.3. Registration form must identify the US Sailing membership category (See eligibility)
- 7.4. Entry fee \$70 for single sailor \$85.00 for two person boat (includes t-shirt, lunch, and dinner at awards)
- 7.5. No entries after December 7th and 8th, 2016.

8. MEASUREMENT

There will be no formal measurement. Random measurement and safety checks may be performed following each race. Failure to display the proper equipment and comply with measurement will result in a protest.

9. SCORING

The Low-Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will be used, except that no score will be excluded unless five or more races have been completed. This changes RRS A2.

10. PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers of each class and will vary depending on class participation.
