NOTICE of RACE

SMWYC invites PHRF, One-Design and Cruiser racers to participate in the *Oktoberfest* Regatta. Level Rating classes such as PHRF 75, Santana 30-30, J24 and M242 will be established but may race within PHRF fleets. The regatta is also an ASMBYC highpoint race event.

Three windward-leeward races from the MdR Course Chart 17 are scheduled for the PHRF & One Design Classes. Area B Buoy ratings apply for the PHRF classes.

Two random leg type races are scheduled for the Cruiser Classes. ASMBYC assigned RLC ratings will apply to the Cruiser Classes as listed on the asmbyc.org website. Boats not listed should use the rating offsets as shown on the ASMBYC website and forward a copy to smwyc.org.

All boats use Regatta Network on the smwyc.org website to register for the race. Three entries are required to establish a class. One Design boats that do not establish a class will race in the PHRF fleet.

The entry fee is \$30.00 (\$25.00 for US Sailing members). Entry deadline is 1500 hours, Friday October 7th.

The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. Sailing Instructions will be available at SMWYC and on the smwyc.org website race page by 1200 hours on Wednesday, October 5th. Classes and Notices will be on the website by 2000 hours on Friday, October 7th with any changes at the SMWYC clubhouse Race Board by 0930 Saturday, October 8th. First Warning signal is at 1155 hours with all starts at 'S' Mark.

The Oktoberfest Party with hors d'oeuvres, German beer and Awards will follow the races at SMWYC. Burgers and hotdogs will be available for purchase. PHRF/OD Class winners will be engraved on SMWYC's Glenn Thorpe Perpetual Trophy.
