NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

Racing shall be governed by the *rules* as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This race is open to boats with a PHRF rating. There will be two classes: Non-Spinnaker and Spinnaker.
- 2.2 The entry fee is \$40. Entries must be received by 2000 hours on Wednesday, 23 November 2016.
- 2.3 A 50% entry fee refund will be provided if the request is received by 2000 hours on Saturday, 19 November 2016.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the EYC website no later than Saturday, 12 November 2016, and posted on the Official Notice Board at the EYC clubhouse.

5 VENUE

- 5.1 The racing area will be on the Severn River.
- 5.2 Post-race activities will be held at the EYC clubhouse.

6 COURSES

Competitors will sail a fixed mark course on the Severn River as described in the Sailing Instructions.

7 PRIZES

- 7.1 Prizes are based on leftover and unclaimed trophies from the previous year(s) – hence, the name of the event. Prizes will be at the discretion of the Race Committee, based on the amount of leftovers.
- 7.2 An award for best-dressed boat/crew will be presented.
- 7.3 An awards & chili party will be held at EYC approximately one (1) hour after the last boat to finish.
- 7.4 Guests are welcome at EYC.

8 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the Leftover Bowl entirely at their own risk; see RRS 4. The organizing authority will accept no liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

9 INSURANCE

Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.

10 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 10.1 This is a Clean Race. All competitors are strongly encouraged to use multi-use water bottles instead of disposable water bottles, and to recycle whenever possible. RRS 55 prohibits placing trash in the water.
