
Drumstick Race

RULES: This race will be governed by the Racing Rules of sailing.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Del Rey Yacht Club members, spouses, family and friends, with keel boats and a VHF radio. **All skippers and helms-persons must be members of DRYC.**

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing Instructions will be available at the club and will be posted on the www.dryc.org website on Thursday, November 17 at 0900.

CLASSES: Classes will be established at the skippers meeting for PHRF, Cruising Class, Novice racers and Dinghies. Inclusion in the Novice, Cruising Class will be at the discretion of the Race Committee. Novice and Cruising class boats that have trophied may be moved into the PHRF division. **Boats that have won trophies in PHRF events or One Design are not eligible to participate in Cruising class.**

SCHEDULE: The order and time of starts will be explained at the skippers meeting. The first warning will be at 1155 hrs.

COURSE: There will be one race. The Start line will be in the vicinity of "S" Mark and the Finish line will be in the vicinity of the DRYC main channel dock. The course will be Random Leg. <u>No</u> Spinnakers may be carried inside the detached breakwater. Dinghies may sail a different course. All boats not finishing by 1630 will be scored DNF.

MANDATORY SKIPPERS MEETING: Sunday, November 20 at 0930. Any race announcements, class splits of PHRF Fleet will be announced at the skippers meeting & posted on the racing board.

ENTRIES: There is <u>NO</u> Entry Fee. Race info is at <u>www.dryc.org</u>. On line entry is at http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/13499 until 1800 hours Saturday, November 19. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the race committee.

Cruising Class/Novice - For Cruising classes, handicap ratings are based on the Marina Del Rey Cruiser handicap system. The Cruiser Handicap Worksheet is available on line at http://mdr-cruising.racingrules.org This form must be submitted per the instructions on the MDR Cruising web site. Cruisers not meeting the 1800 deadline on Friday, November 18, will be assigned one by the race committee. The Cruising rating assigned by the RC will be good only for this race. No exceptions.

HANDICAP & RATINGS: The Cruising Handicaps (PHRF area B RLC adjusted) will be used for the Cruising/Novice Fleet for this race. PHRF area B RLC Ratings will be used for PHRF Classes.
