1. Rules

This race will be governed by the rules as defined by the *Racing Rules of Sailing, 2013 - 2016 (RRS)*, the PHRF-SoCal Class Rules, and those of participating classes. Any modifications to the RRS will be noted in the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility

This regatta is open to all one design and PHRF classes. A minimum of (2) two boats is required to establish a class, receive a start and a trophy. For PHRF boats, area buoy handicaps will be used. Handicap ratings will be applied per certificate or by listing, if not certified.

Entrants must be members in good standing with a home club recognized by the SCYA or other regional yachting association.

5. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at the on-site registration and online after October 22nd.

6. Racing Area and Course

The racing will be held off the breakwater of Santa Barbara. Courses to be sailed will be Windward-Leeward and variations thereof as described in the Sailing Instructions.

7. Scoring

The Goblin Regatta will be scored using the RRS Appendix A low-point system. PHRF scoring will be Time-over-Time. All races will be counted towards series score. If there are eight races or more, the worst score will be excluded from the series total.

8. Prizes

Trophies will be awarded based on the number of entries per class.

9. Social Event – Saturday, October 29th

Dinner and drinks will be available in the SBSC yard after racing. Additional meal tickets can be purchased for \$10.00. Beverages: water or soft drinks \$1.00; beer \$3.00; margaritas \$5.00.

10. Location of Onshore Events

Registration, skippers' meeting, dinner, and awards will be held in the SBSC yard.

11. Mooring/Storage

The SBYC end-tie dock is available on a 'first-come, first-serve basis', beginning Friday October 28th. Additional slips are available in the marina. Please see the harbor master. Fees apply.

Boat and trailer storage is available beginning Friday. The city has overnight parking for boats on trailers at the harbor boat launch. Competitors are responsible for parking fees. Additional trailer storage is available on a 'first-come, first serve' basis in the city yard adjacent to the SBSC facility.
