NOR LOGISTICAL ADDENDUM

Due to changing circumstances and new realizations, we want to simplify and clarify several logistical aspects of the regatta. Please read this addendum fully, as **some of this information supersedes information in sections 5 and 6 of the Notice of Race**.

A. MONDAY DROP-OFF

- 1. The OYC Junior Sailing Program will be operating normally on Monday, July 17th. Due to MA camp regulations and space constraints, boats may only be delivered to the OYC after **4:30 PM** on Monday. There will not be space in the OYC parking lot to unload boats before 4:30 PM; thus, we are regrettably unable to make any exceptions to this rule.
- 2. If you plan to drop boats off on Monday afternoon/evening, please call or text John Holbrook (304-710-9137) and/or Warren Silver (508-776-5815) by 12:00 PM (noon) on Monday. Please let us know the approximate time you plan to arrive and approximately how many cars/trailers you will be bringing so that we can accommodate you.
- 3. No vehicles or trailers may be left in the OYC parking lot overnight. After unloading, those wishing to leave trailers in Orleans overnight should move the trailers to the NRMS north lot as detailed in section (B)(1).

B. TUESDAY MORNING DROP-OFF AND UNLOADING

- 1. All competitor vehicles and trailers will be parked in the north parking lot at Nauset Regional Middle School, located at 70 Route 28 in Orleans. The north parking lot is on the right if you are facing the building from Route 28.
- 2. There is only room in the OYC parking lot for 3-4 vehicles with trailers to unload at once. Thus, we ask that **all vehicles report directly to the NRMS parking lot on Tuesday morning**. Vehicles which need to unload at the OYC will be directed to proceed to the OYC parking lot as space is available and in the order they arrive at NRMS. Once vehicles and trailers have been unloaded, they must return to the NRMS lot to free up space at the OYC. Please plan your arrival time on Tuesday morning in accordance with this procedure.
- 3. Coach boats will follow the same procedure outlined above, and can launch at the public boat ramp next door to the OYC.
- 4. OYC representatives will be stationed in the NRMS north parking lot and at the top of the OYC hill (intersection of Cove Road and Route 28), and will communicate with representatives in the OYC parking lot to coordinate the unloading process.
- 5. The NRMS north lot is located 0.4 miles (~8 minute walk) from the OYC.
- 6. Please **do not** park vehicles or trailers in the OYC lot, in the adjacent Town of Orleans lot, in the Stop and Shop lot, or at any location other than the NRMS

north parking lot. We apologize for any confusion or inconvenience caused by this change of plan.

C. AFTERNOON PACK-UP/LOADING

- 1. At the end of the day, vehicles and trailers may be loaded/packed in the order that they are ready.
- 2. In order to minimize congestion, we ask that vehicles and trailers be loaded as quickly as possible, and that they not be retrieved from the NRMS north lot until everything is ready to be loaded.
- 3. OYC representatives will be stationed in the NRMS north parking lot and at the top of the OYC hill (intersection of Cove Road and Route 28), and will communicate with representatives in the OYC parking lot to coordinate the loading process.

D. DOLLIES

1. Beach space at the OYC is limited. Boats will need to be transported and stored over pavement and gravel, and may be launched from a concrete boat ramp if space and traffic allow. Thus, we ask that all competitors bring dollies to facilitate the transport and launching of their boats. Each boat should have its own dolly.
