



Del Rey Yacht Club Berger/Stein Series, Race #3 – Pt. Dume Saturday, May 6, 2017 Sailing Instructions



1 RULES

- 1.1 This race shall be governed by the “**rules**” as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 PHRF of So. California Rule #8 (Marine Industry Racer) does not apply. Individuals that satisfy the definition of “Marine Industry Racer” may not steer a boat in the Cruising Division.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to Competitors will be posted by 0900 race day on a bulletin board inside the DRYC Clubhouse and may be downloaded at DRYC.org.

3 SCHEDULE; CLASSES AND CLASS FLAGS

- 3.1 There will be no Skippers meeting race day.
- 3.2 Class flags and the order of starts will be posted no later than 0900 race day.
- 3.3 There will be no Check In.
- 3.4 The Warning Signal for the first start will be at 1155. Multiple horn courtesy sound at 1154.

4 COURSE AND MARKS

From the starting line:

Berger – PHRF and ORCA Classes

BERGER COURSE

- a. Round the **Yellow** inflatable mark located at approximately 34° 00.000 N and 118° 47.000 W, leaving the mark to port.

Stein – Cruising Classes

STEIN COURSE

- a. Round the white with blue stripe metal buoy labeled “CG” located at approximately 34° 02.096 N and 118° 40.222 W, leaving the buoy to port.
- b. Round the **Yellow** inflatable mark located to the south of the MDR detached breakwater at approximately 33° 57.384 N and 118° 27.615 W, leaving the mark to port. The RC will attempt to have a strobe on this mark.
- c. Proceed to the finishing line.

5 THE START

- 5.1 The starting area will be in the vicinity of MDR H Mark (see MDR Course Chart 17).
- 5.2 The starting line will be between an **Orange** inflatable mark and an **Orange** flag on the R/C boat.
- 5.3 The Starting Signal for a class will be the Warning Signal for the next class. This changes RRS 26.
- 5.4 The RC will attempt to announce starting information and recalls on VHF 68.

6 THE FINISH

- 6.1** The finishing line will be between the green light on the south end of the detached breakwater and an orange flag on the RC boat (anchored behind the detached breakwater near the south entrance to the MDR harbor).
- 6.2** Note your finish time (GPS) and boats that finish ahead and behind.
- 6.3** The RC boat intends to be on station until 2030. If the RC boat is not on station, record your finish time (GPS) when the green light on the south end of the detached breakwater bears 200° from your bow.
- 6.4** **If approaching the finishing line after dark**, boats shall notify the RC boat via VHF 68 as they approach the rounding mark and shall shine a light on their sail numbers as they finish.

7 PROTESTS

- 7.1** Boats shall notify the RC of their intention to protest within two hours after finishing, either in person at DRYC or via the contact phone number in **SI 12**.
- 7.2** Protests shall be filed at DRYC no later than noon on the day after race day (Protest Time Limit). Hearings will be scheduled for a later date.

8 HANDICAP RATINGS / SCORING

- 8.1** The course length for the Berger division is 32.5 nm and for Stein division 22.2 nm.
- 8.2** For the PHRF division, Area B RLC ratings will apply (including adjustments for “out of area entries”). For ORCA division, ORCA ratings will apply.
- 8.3** Boats in the Stein (Cruising) Division will be scored with 2017 or 2016 MDR validated ratings for the entire series. Boats without ratings will be assigned one by the Race Committee. Boats must race in the configuration indicated by their rating. PHRF Corinthian ratings are not valid for this series and will not be used for this series

9 TROPHIES

Trophies will be presented at the DRYC Sundown event Friday July 21st. Details are on the DRYC.org website.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

The RC will attempt to monitor and announce starting information and recalls on VHF 68.

11 CLUB FACILITIES

Participants are welcome to use DRYC club facilities race day.
