Rules:

1. The organizing authority is the International Lightning Class Association, Southeastern District.
2. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS), the Prescriptions of US SAILING, The International Lightning Class Rules, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and any amendments thereto.
3. RRS 44.2 shall apply, except that when a boat has her spinnaker drawing at the time of the breach, her penalty shall be a one-turn penalty with the head of her spinnaker below the gooseneck from the time she passes head-to-wind until she is on a downwind course.
4. US Sailing Appendix T Sections B (Post Race Penalties) and C (Expedited Hearings) shall apply.

Eligibility:

1. The regatta is open to all lightning class sailboats holding a valid measurement certificate and a 2017 ILCA Membership Decal.

Courses:

The courses will be Windward/Leeward.

Scoring:

Scoring will be according to the Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A, except all races will be scored. This changes RRS A.2. One race will constitute a regatta.

Radio Communication:

Use of hand held VHF radios will be permitted for communication from the Race Committee to competitors on a predetermined channel to be identified in the Sailing Instructions. The Race Committee intends to use VHF radio to identify OCS (On Course Side of the line) boats after starts and otherwise communicate with the fleet on the water. Failure to receive a hail, for a hail to be made, the order of hails made, or receive other communications to the fleet shall not be cause for redress.

Trophies:

Trophies will be awarded to the top 5 boats.

Lodging:

Camping is welcome on the grounds of CSC and campers are invited to use the showers and restroom facilities.

Club Rules do not allow pets or open fires on the club grounds.

Directions:

From I-26 in either direction, take exit 102, Lake Murray Blvd. Go West on Lake Murray Blvd 3.8 miles and turn right on North Lake Road. Proceed 0.5 miles and turn left on Shuler Road (First left). CSC will be at the end of Shuler Road.
