SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RULES

1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), and the rules of the Harbor 20 Class Association and Harbor 20 Fleet 1.

2. ENTRIES

- 2.1 The Regatta is open to all members of the Harbor 20 Class Fleet 1
- 2.2 An entry must be submitted and accepted by Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club. The individual submitting the entry will be regarded as responsible for the boat throughout the event.
- 2.3 An entrant must be a member of a Member Organization of US SAILING, a US Sailing Regional Sailing Authority (such as SCYA) or, in the case of a foreign entry, by its national sailing authority.

3. PENALTIES

RRS 44.1 is changed to a One Turn Penalty.

4. RACING AREA

The Racing Area will be in Newport Harbor in the Five Points area.

5. COURSES AND MARKS

- 5.1. Courses will be windward/leeward.
- 5.2. The course for each class will be displayed from the Race Committee boat before the Warning Signal for that class.
- 5.3. "W" is the orange tetrahedron to windward of the start line. It shall be taken to port.
- 5.4. "O" is a yellow tetrahedron offset from the windward mark. It shall be taken to port.
- 5.5. "L" is the orange tetrahedron to leeward of the windward mark. It shall be taken to port.
- 5.6. "G" is the leeward gate comprised of two (2) round red buoys.
- 5.7. The possible courses to sail are shown in Attachment 1.

6. CHECK-IN

- 6.1 Before the first Warning Signal for the first race, each boat shall: 1) sail past the Race Committee boat on starboard tack; 2) hail her sail number; and 3) obtain recognition of her sail number by the Race Committee.

7. START/FINISH and CLASS FLAGS

- 7.1 The first warning signal each day is scheduled for 1300 hours.
- 7.2 The Start line will be between an orange flag on the Race Committee Signal Boat and an orange flag on a staff.
- 7.3 The Finish Line will be an orange flag on a Race Committee Finish-Line Boat and an orange flag on a staff.
- 7.4 Races will be started using RRS 26 modified for 3-minutes. This changes RRS 26.
- 7.5 The order of start can be determined by the Class Flag (below) hoisted at the Warning Signal:

- 7.6 Boats whose Warning Signal have not been made shall keep clear of the starting area and of boats starting and finishing.

8. TIME LIMIT

- 8.1 Boats failing to finish within ten (10) minutes after the first boat finishes in their start class will be scored "DNF" without a hearing.

9. PROTESTS

- 9.1 A boat intending to protest shall comply with *RRS* 60 & 61.1 and notify the Race Committee at the finish line of her intention to protest and identify the other boats involved.
- 9.2 Protests shall be on written forms, which are available at the BCYC Front Office. Protests shall be delivered there within the Protest Time Limit.
- 9.3 For each class the Protest Time Limit is 60 minutes after the Race Committee Finish Boat has docked. This changes *RRS* 61.3
- 9.4 Notices will be posted within 30 minutes of the Protest Time Limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses.
- 9.5 Hearings will be held at BCYC and will start within one hour of the Protest Time Limit.

10. SCORING

- 10.1 The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 10.2 A boat that did not start, did not finish, retired, or was disqualified shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of **starters** in the race. This modifies RRS A4.2.
- 10.3 The Series Score will be the sum of the total scores for each day's racing. No race scores will be excluded. This modifies RRS A2.
- 10.4 RRS A9 shall not apply.

11. PRIZES

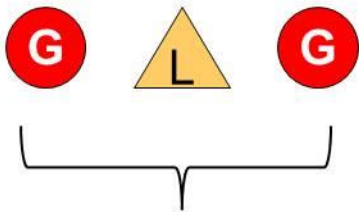
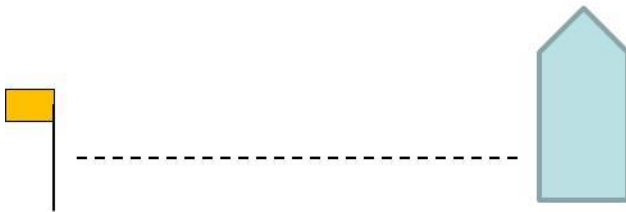
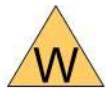
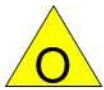
Prizes will be presented at BCYC after the last race each day.

RRS 26 MODIFIED STARTING SIGNALS

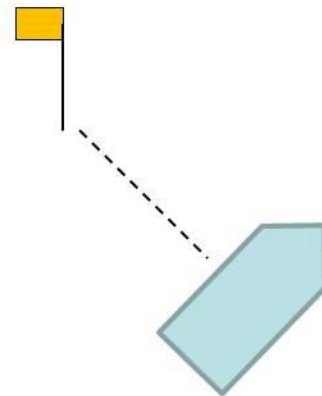
SIGNAL	SOUND	FLAG	MEANING
Warning	1 horn	Class Flag Up	3 minutes until start
Preparatory	1 horn	"P" Flag Up	2 minutes until start
	1 long horn	"P" Flag Down	1 minute until start
Start	1 horn	Class Flag Down	START
