



ARRIVAL AND MEASUREMENT INSTRUCTIONS

Prior to Arrival:

- Please reserve your measurement time slot via the online SLOTTTR application: <http://www.slottr.com/sheets/5138702>. Time slots are available on a first-come/first-serve basis. PLEASE PLAN TO BE A FEW MINUTES EARLY TO THE TIME SLOT SELECTED. If you are late to the chosen time slot, you may be required to wait until the next available slot.
- Proof of insurance (\$300k USD) is required for this event. You may email your certificate of insurance to stuhlmiller@yahoo.com in advance of the event or you may submit a hard copy at registration.
- Measurement LITE. If your boat was weighed and measured at the 2016 J/22 Worlds, you are eligible for a simplified boat measurement. Simply complete the Affidavit attached hereto as Exhibit A and return to stuhlmiller@yahoo.com in advance of the event.
- Please remember to bring your passports if you wish to travel to Canada during your stay.

Upon Arrival:

- Welcome to the Buffalo Yacht Club! Depending on traffic conditions, a BYC attendant may be stationed at the entrance to the Club driveway (No. 1 on the map).
- Prior to completing measurement, you may park your boat/trailer in the Dry Sail area (No. 3 on the map). Please note that absolutely no vehicles will be allowed to park in the Dry Sail area, so please plan accordingly. Parking for vehicles is denoted on Exhibit B.
- Registration will be in the general vicinity of the Clubhouse (No. 2 on map). Please check in upon arrival and you will receive a welcome packet and registration checklist. Sail measurement drop-off/pick-up and the crew weighing station will also be located in this area. Included in your packet will be a bow number and a corresponding trailer number. Please affix the trailer number as soon as possible, as this will facilitate our off-site storage of trailers.
- Boat measurement will take place in the vicinity of the hoists in the Dry Sail Area (No. 3 on map). Please be sure to arrive a few minutes early to your scheduled time. If you are NOT eligible for Measurement LITE, please remove everything but your running rigging from the boat and place them in the receptacle provided by staff. Instructions for measurement (and Measurement LITE) will be provided at registration.

Upon Departure:

- Immediately after the last race on Sunday, please send a crew member up to the Dry Dock area and add your bow number, name and cell phone number to the white board queue placed in the vicinity of the hoists. We will retrieve your trailers and haul out boats on a first-come/first-serve basis based exclusively on this queue. Please do not position your boat under the cranes until your bow number has been called. With two hoists and experienced operators, we should have everyone out of the water in about 60 minutes. To keep the process moving quickly for all, we ask that you do not keep your boat in mid-air (scrubbing, etc...) for longer than 1 minute. Also, no vehicles will be allowed in the Dry Dock area until all boats are pulled. Have a beer and relax.

AFFIDAVIT OF NO CHANGE

The Organizing Authority, with approval from the J/22 International Class Association, has determined that boats weighed and measured for competition in the 2016 World Championships may undergo a simplified measurement process - so long as no modifications have been made to such boats subsequent to the 2016 World Championships.

As such, by signing this form, you attest that: (i) you presently possess a valid J/22 International Class Certificate for your Boat (indicated by the Hull number below); (ii) the Boat was weighed and measured at the 2016 World Championships; and (iii) no changes of any kind have been made to the Boat (i.e. weights removed or modified) since that time.
