1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing
- 1.2. In the event there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.
- 1.3. There shall be no protests for violations of the US Sailing prescription to rule 40.
- 1.4. The boat shall be equipped with a personal floatation device for each crew member to the minimum standard ISO 12402-5 (Level 50), or EN 393 50N, USCG Type III, or AUS PFD 1. This applies to all boats.
- 1.5. Rule 40 is changed as follows: All competitors on board boats 21' and under shall wear personal flotation devices as defined by NOR 1.4 while racing, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be displayed.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all beach multihulls under 21 feet with a valid SCHRS rating (www.schrs.com/rating.php).
- 2.2. Boats which are modified must declare all modifications at the time of registration. Failure to do so will result in a score of DNE without a hearing.
- 2.3. Larger multihulls are welcome, but need prior approval from the Organizing Authority. Criteria which will be considered are the possibility of capsize and/or ability to right without outside assistance. This is due to a USCG request to the Organizing Authority. - 2.4. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at (http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/14092) and paying the required fee by June 15, 2017.
- 2.5. Late entries may be made in person during on-site registration (see NOR 3.5). Late entries may also be made online.
- 2.6. Only boats having completed all registration requirements will be allowed to compete.

3. FEES

- 3.1. Double handed fee is \$70.
- 3.2. Single-Handed fee is \$55.
- 3.3. Youth Team fee (all participants under 21) is \$20.
- 3.4. Boats with three or more crew on board shall be charged the doublehanded fee plus \$15 for each crewmember above the number of two.
- 3.5. Late registration fee shall be an additional \$15 added to the registration fee.
- 3.6. There shall be no refunds for cancelled entries.

4.3.1. The make-up date will only be used as an absolute last resort.

5. MEASUREMENT

5.1. The Organizing Authority will make all reasonable attempts to accommodate modified boats, but must be informed of all modifications at the time of registration.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1. Final Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.
- 6.2. Preliminary Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website on or before June 25, 2017.

7. THE COURSE

7.1. The course shall start in the waters of Sandy Hook Bay and will consist of a course approximately 19 statute miles one way to buoy "G33" which is one of the closest navigational buoys to the Statue of Liberty.

- 7.2. All sailors must stay clear of the security zone surrounding Earle Naval Pier. Any boat entering the zone will be disqualified without a hearing. There may not be any buoys marking its position.
- 7.3. Additional marks may be added in the Sailing Instructions or at the skippers' meeting with a posting on the official notice board.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1. RRS Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 8.2. Failure of a boat to present a measurement certificate shall not be protestable by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

9. ELECTRONIC DEVICES

- 9.1. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. VHF communications and monitoring are strongly encouraged on any channel freely available to recreational boats.
- 9.2. The use of GPS units is allowed and encouraged.
- 9.3. Boats are encouraged, but not required to use RaceQs to monitor their positions. Failure to do so shall not be grounds for protest. The event page can be viewed here: (http://www.raceqs.com/regattas/56355).
- 9.4. Per USCG request, all boats shall be required to carry a VHF radio and monitor channel 72. Failure to adhere to this requirement shall not be grounds for protest. The specific channel may be changed at the skippers' meeting.

10. PRIZES

- 10.1. Worrell Cup Line Honors
- 10.2. Jackson Memorial Cup 1st single-handed (corrected)
- 10.3. Manhattan YC Cup 1st corrected
- 10.4. Founders Cup 1st SHBCC boat back (corrected)
- 10.5. Wind Water and Wheels 1st for the largest class
- 10.6. Little Miss Liberty Cup Verrazano Bridge Race
- 10.7. Other spot prizes may be awarded by the Organizing Authority.

11. RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in the 2017 Statue of Liberty Marathon, a competitor automatically grants to the organizers and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. BEACH RULES

- 13.1. Parking lot captain instructions must be obeyed.
- 13.2. Do not move boats on wheels above the high water line when sails are up.
- 13.3. No glass on the beach.
- 13.4. Cars and trailers are not permitted on the sand beach. Use a dolly to move boats from the parking lot to the beach spot.
- 13.5. Do not block the beach gate.
- 13.6. This list of rules is not complete and competitors may be subject to additional facility rules of conduct.

14. ACCOMODATIONS AT SHBCC

- 14.1. RV's are welcome at the Sandy Hook Bay Catamaran Club for a fee of \$30 for the weekend. Availability is limited, reservations must be made with regatta chair, Justin LaBarca: shbccraceprogram@gmail.com
