Rendezvous: At Choptank River Light at 0900 (Area Mark O). Competitors please check in with Race Committee boat prior to warning signal. A yacht in the starting area other than at her authorized time can expect to be protested by the Race Committee.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Start: Starting area will be approximately 1.2 nautical miles SW of the Choptank Light (Area Mark O) toward G13 (Area Mark A) at about N 38° 38.65' W 076°12.35'. Starting line will be between orange flag on Race Committee boat and a nearby drop mark. Second race will start as soon as possible after the first race. **2 Race Series!**

Course: Either drop mark or Region 3 Choptank Area Standard Racing Marks, as designated by letters displayed on the Race Committee boat.

Finish: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and a drop mark or government mark in immediate vicinity of Race Committee boat. If shortened, all classes finish between a mark of the original course and orange flag on Race Committee boat.

Time Limit: 3 hours.

Protests: Written protests must be delivered to the Race Committee Chairman within one hour after the Race Committee Boat docks. Protests will be heard as soon as possible after completion of races.

Awards: Trophies for 1st/3, 2nd/5 & 3rd/7+ will be awarded following the races. Perpetual trophies will be given at Harleigh Presentation at 1600 on Sunday 13 August 2017 (coat & tie). Awards will be given for these 2 races combined as well as the 3 race series that includes Friday's race from Annapolis.

Social: Tender service between club and moorings provided. A la carte meals starting with breakfast at 0700 will be served throughout the day. Bringing alcoholic beverages to and from the club premises is unlawful.
