## NOTICE OF RACE

**Organizing Authorities:** Halifax Sailing Association, 15 Fremont Ct, Daytona Beach, FL 32114

### 1 Rules

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), including the prescriptions of US Sailing, except as noted and changed by the sailing instructions.
- 1.2 USCG approved life jackets must be worn while on the water.

### 2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Registration will be available on Regatta Network and also onsite the morning of competition.
- 2.2 The distance race is open to all boats with a valid Portsmouth rating.
- 2.3 The buoy course will be open to all youth sailors competing in the Opti (GRWB), 420 (no trap/spin) and Laser Radial.
- 2.4 Any modifications a competitor makes to a boat that violates its class's rules must be noted on the registration application.

### 3 Fees

Adult Multi-Crew: \$35 (Early registration discount fee - \$25 before 3/18). Adult Singlehanded: \$25 (Early registration discount fee - \$15 before 3/18). Youth Sailors (17 years and younger): \$15 (Early registration discount fee - \$10 before 3/18)

### 5 Venue

Racing will be on and around the intracoastal waterway, locally known as the Halifax River, between the Orange Avenue Bridge and the Dunlawton Bridge.

### 6 Course

The specific details for the distance course and buoy course will be covered during the skippers meeting.

### 7 Scoring

- 7.1 The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A2 of RRS will apply for the buoy course.
- 7.2 The distance race will be scored on corrected time.

### 8 Awards

- 8.1 Awards will be given to the top 3 boats in each division.
- 8.2 The Founders Cup trophy will be awarded to the top youth decided upon by the coaches and race officials.

### 9 Disclaimer of Liability

All competitors will be required to sign a waiver of liability as a condition of entry. Parents/guardians must sign for competitors under 18.
