NOTICE OF RACE

The Junior Sailors of The Lake George Club cordially invite junior sailors from neighboring clubs to participate in the 2017 Cheeseburger Regatta. This annual regatta on picturesque Lake George- the "Queen of American Lakes "- in the southern Adirondack Mountains of New York State alternates between The Lake George Club (odd years) and the Northern Lake George Club (even years). It features racing in single-handed Optimist and double- handed Flying Junior Dinghies, and has great hospitality, a beautiful setting, lots of competitive racing, and usually favorable winds.

Site: The Lake George Club, 4000 Lake Shore Drive, Diamond Point, New York. The Lake George Club is located five miles north of Lake George Village on Route 9N. Races normally take place in front on the Lake George Club with an excellent view from the Club for spectators.

Rules: This regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2017- 2020 (RRS), the United States Sailing Association Prescriptions, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility: Open to Optimist ages 15 and under and Flying Junior sailors ages 17 and under (as long as you are not turning 18 before December 31, 2015) from the following clubs: Adirondack Camp, Burlington Community Sailing Center, Lake Champlain YC, The Lake George Club, Mallet's Bay YC, Northern Lake George YC, Saratoga Lake Sailing Club and Lake Sunapee. Sailors from other regional clubs may be eligible upon application to the Regatta Chairs of the organizing club.

Scoring: The low point scoring system if Appendix A of the RRS will apply (as modified the Sailing Instructions). A yacht's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. There will be no throw-out races.

Races: We will have as many races as conditions and time permit, at the discretion of the Race Committee. One race shall constitute a series.

Penalties and Protests: Protests must be filed in writing within the one hour Protest Time (approximately the hour following the Committee Boat reaching the dock). See the Sailing Instructions for additional information.

Registration: The following Registration Information is requested by July 7th, from participating Clubs:

Name(s), telephone number, and email address of Junior Program Coordinator(s).

Name(s) of sailing instructors accompanying the sailors.

Name(s) of any parents or other chaperones accompanying the sailors. Names, ages, and gender of all attending junior sailors from your club, specify whether they are sailing Opti or a FJ, and if they need housing. We will try to accommodate housing, but cannot guarantee it.

Please specify any special conditions and allergies. Please also remember we only accept cash or check while using our facilities.

Number of Opti and number of FJ boats you are bringing to the club.

Prizes: Trophies for first, second, third, fourth & fifth Opti Skipper, and first, second, third, fourth & fifth FJ Skipper and Crew, plus an Overall Sportsmanship award will be presented following lunch on Friday. Daily's will be awarded as well.

Prohibited Equipment: FJ - bow spirits and 4 batten mainsails.

Boat Washing: Lake George is clear and clean drinking water, and we are very concerned about the introduction of foreign organisms, particularly Zebra Mussels and Eurasian Milfoil. Before arriving at Lake George, please drain all water and wash your hull, rudder and centerboard. Be sure your sails are dry. We will have pressure washer facilities at the Club and will require suspect boats to be thoroughly washed before launching (in upper parking lot only, not on the beach). Your understanding and cooperation will be very much appreciated.
