Rules: This regatta will be governed by ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 and the prescriptions of US Sailing and the applicable one-design class associations, except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions. The low point scoring system Appendix A will apply. Each boat's score will be the sum of all races.

Registration Details:

Singlehand Registration - \$65.00 - Includes 1 meal and 1 regatta shirt.

Doublehand Registration - \$85.00 - Includes 2 meals and 2 regatta shirts.

Triplehand Registration - \$105.00 - Includes 3 meals and 3 regatta shirts.

Please add camping registration in the express checkout on Regatta Network, which is \$30 / tent. Additional regatta shirts, meals, camping spaces, and even childcare can be added in the express checkout.

*Regatta shirts are only guaranteed for registrants received **BEFORE Monday July 24, 2016.**

**Saturday dinner is Bring Your Own Meat (BYOM). The included meal in your registration includes sides, desserts, non-alcoholic refreshments and condiments. A BBQ is provided for meat and vegetarian options.

Dinner – 6:00pm (or as soon as possible after racing at the campground)

There is no limit on the number of races

Eligibility: This regatta is open to all one-design sailing dinghies and catamarans, such as Lido, Europe's, Tasars, Lasers, Vanguard 15's, Coronado 15's, Snipes, Thistles, Day sailors, Flying Scots, Lightning's, 420's, 470's, 505's, A-Cats, Scamps, i550's and more. Two boats will constitute a fleet.

Racing: We are planning on sailing as many races as possible. There will be no races started after 3pm on Sunday.

Launching/Parking: Yale Park (Day-use area) will be the host site for all sailing activities including awards and skippers meeting. Saturday BBQ will be held at the group campground at Beaver Bay. The park has real restrooms, 4-lane launch with a small dock and overnight (mast-up) boat parking.

Lodging or Camping Options: We have reserved a number and individual camp sites (Tent and NON hookup RV only) at Beaver Bay Campground at Yale Lake. The camp is at a different location than the boat launch. The individual site check-in is available on August 4, 5, and 6 at 16:00 and the main access gate closes at 21:00 each night. For those of you wanting to camp out early on the 4th, there are limited campsite reservations. The Town of Cougar, Washington has other Lodging, B&B, RV sites with hook up, store, gas station and restaurants. Cougar is an 8-minute drive to the Beaver Bay Campground and Yale Park boat launch.

About the Lake: Yale Lake is a 3,780 acre reservoir on the Lewis River at the South foot of Mt. Saint Helens. Two boat launches are located on the lake. The normal wind pattern runs northerly from the dam end at a steady 12-16 knots, making for ideal sailing conditions.
