The following amendments are made to the Sailing Instructions for the 2017 Sunstroke Series:

5.3 "The order of starts will be announced on the water by the RC (See SI 7)." Is amended to read, "No order of starts will be announced."

7.2 "Competitors may not sail at any time in the area between the two lines of "No Sail" buoys and their respective jetties. The line between any two adjacent "No Sail" buoys is considered a continuing obstruction for the purpose of safety. A "two turns" penalty will apply to any competitor who breaks SI 7.3."

Is amended to read, "Competitors may not sail at any time in the area between the two lines of "No Sail" buoys and their respective jetties. The line between any two adjacent "No Sail" buoys is considered a continuing obstruction for the purpose of safety. A "two turns" penalty will apply to any competitor who breaks SI 7.2."

9.6 "Boats not registered or informing the RC under 9.4 will be asked to leave the starting area."

Is amended to read. "Boats not registered or informing the RC under 9.5 will be asked to leave the starting area."

11.1 "The finishing line will be between Mark S at one end and Mark F at the other end."

Is amended to read, "The finishing line will be between Mark S at one end and *an orange flag on the race committee boat at the opposite end.*"

13.3 "Overall standings will be calculated by taking each boat's weekly score and dividing it by the number of boats entered in her class (i.e. finished 1st out of 10 boats racing, 1/10=.1). These scores are added together to make the overall score, with the lowest score being the winner. There are no throwouts for the overall trophy."

Is amended to read, "Overall standings will be calculated by taking each boat's weekly *position* and dividing it by the number of boats entered in her class (i.e. finished 1st out of 10 boats racing, 1/10=.1).
