Notice of Race

1. RULES

- a. The Organizing Authority and host of the regatta is the Upper Keys Sailing Club.
- b. The regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- c. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- d. RRS 40 is modified as follows competitors shall wear while on the water, other than for brief periods while adding or removing clothing, a properly secured personal floatation device. Failure to do so may be grounds for protest by the Race Committee.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- a. The regatta is open to all boats of the Club 420, High School C420, Laser Standard, Laser Radial, and Laser 4.7 classes.
- b. Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration, medical and waiver forms on line and paying the entry fee through Regatta Network.

3. REGISTRATION & FEES

 a. Registrations fees are as follows: \$100 per boat for all C420 fleets.

\$75 per boat for all Laser classes.

b. Sailors will receive lunch on the water and Pizza post-race on both days.

4. SCHEDULE

5. SUPPORT BOATS

- a. Support and coach boats must register with the organizing authority and provide the names of competitors they support. Each support and coach boat must carry a VHF radio, monitoring the channel provided for each of their sailors' course at all times while on the water.
- b. Support boats may use the sailing club's ramp to launch their boats.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

a. The sailing instructions will be available at registration and posted on the official notice board.

7. VENUE

- a. Boats will launch from the Upper Keys Sailing Club in Key Largo, FL.
- b. The racing areas will be on Buttonwood Sound.

8. THE COURSES

a. The courses will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

9. SCORING

- a. One race for a class will constitute a regatta.
- b. The worst score will be excluded with the completion of six (6) races. The next-worst score will be excluded with the completion of ten (10) races.

10. PRIZES

a. Prizes will be awarded to each fleet with 5 boats or more.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

a. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. Photographers and TV Rights

a. Competitors give absolute right and permission for any photographs or video footage taken of them or their competing boat to be published in any media whatsoever; for editorial or advertising purposes, or to be used in press information.

13. Parking

a. Vehicle parking is available at a designated event parking lot less than a block outside the main gate along Ocean Bay Drive. Trailers may be parked at the Capital Bank lot after bank hours located at 99451 Overseas Hwy. Vehicles parked along the residential streets outside of the sailing club risk being towed!
