- 1. Rules: The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
 - 1.1. **RRS 29.2** <u>General Recall</u> is modified to allow the race committee to use any amount of time it wishes after the lowering of the general recall flag before resuming racing operations.
 - 1.2. **RRS 61.1(a)2** is deleted. All boats shall comply with RRS 61.1.
- 2. Eligibility: The regatta is open to any Flying Scot. Skippers must be current members of the FSSA.
- 3. **Registration:** Skippers can register online through Regatta Network (<u>www.regattanetwork.com</u>); by mail using the form available under the <u>Racing</u> section of the ECSC web site (http://www.ecsail.org/racing.htm) or in person at the regatta site before 10:00 am, 2017 at 5:00 pm. Sailing Instructions will be available on Regatta Network, on the ECSC web site and at the registration table.
- 4. **Measurement:** All boats may be checked for safety equipment as required by the FSSA rules.
- 5. **Fees: R**egistration fee is \$90 and includes a complete meal package for skipper and one crew. Meal package includes: Friday dinner; Saturday breakfast, lunch, dinner; Sunday breakfast, lunch.
