1. Eligibility & Fees

- 1.1 There will be starts for 29er, C420, CFJ, Laser Radial, Opti Championship and Opti Green and RS Terra..
- 1.2 A minimum of 5 boats is needed to constitute a fleet (except the 29er, minimum of 3).
- 1.3 Results will be scored as part of the BAYS 2017 Summer Series
- 1.4 Eligible boats may enter at the following link by June 8th. **Advanced registration is mandatory.**

- 1.5 The entry fee for this regatta is \$40 per sailor.

2. Rules

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing and the class rules and as modified by the NOR and Sailing Instructions for this Regatta.

3. SCHEDULE of Events

Saturday

- 11:00-11:30 Registration
- 12:00 Competitor's meeting
- 13:00 First warning

Sunday

- 12:00 Possible Competitor's meeting depending on conditions
- 13:00 First warning
- 16:30 No race started after this time
- ASAP Trophy presentation

4. RACING AREA

- 4.1 Alpha course (CFJs, Opti Green and RS Terra's) will be located in front of Parents point. Inside the outer breakwall to the left of RYC or announced at the skippers meeting.
- 4.2 Bravo course will be located either at Keller's Cove, Southampton Shoals or will be announced in the morning of each race day.

5. COACHING AND SUPPORT BOATS

After the warning signal for a given race, coaching will not be permitted on the Bravo course until a competitor has finished that race. To avoid any interference with boats still racing.

- 5.1 Coaching the back of the Opti Green fleet is permitted while they race. Coaches must stay out of the way of other competitors racing while doing so.

6. SAFETY

Each competitor must wear adequate buoyancy, properly secured at all times, on the dock and while on the water. Wetsuits, drysuits and inflatable PFD's do not constitute adequate buoyancy.

7. Liability

Participants compete entirely at their own risk. Each competitor and their parent/Guardian must sign waiver before competing.
