# 2017 ILYA IOD Championship Regatta

## Notice of Race

### 1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The organizing authority (OA) for this regatta is the Inland Lakes Yachting Association (ILYA).

### 2. RULES

2.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2.2 RRS 33.(c) is changed as follows: After the start, minor adjustments in a mark's location can be made and will not be signaled.

2.3 RRS 35, A4.2, and A11 are changed as follows: Boats still racing 25 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored TLE (Time Limit Expired), the position of the last boat that complies with RRS 28 to finish plus 2. This changes RRS 35, A4.2, and A11.

2.4 RRS 30.1 is changed as follows: If a mid-line boat is in place in accordance with SI 5.3, a boat may return to the pre-start side of the starting line around the mid-line boat, leaving it to port, before starting.

2.5 RRS 62.1(a) is modified as follows: Following the display of Code Flag "X", every effort will be made to hail a complete list of boats identified on the course side at the start or needing to comply with RRS 30.1 as quickly and clearly as possible by loud hailer. Please note that due to this hail being a courtesy, it is extremely unlikely that redress will be granted because of the order of numbers called, failure to hear a hail, or failure to understand a hail. This changes RRS 41.

2.6 RRS A2.1 is changed as follows: Each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. If six or more races have been completed, each boat shall discard her worst score, except where prohibited under RRS 90.3(b).

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 Class IOD Championship entries shall be split into white, blue and red fleets according to the age of the helmsperson as follows:

White Fleet (8-10 years) Helmspersons who are eight or nine or ten years of age on July 30, 2017.

Blue Fleet (11-12 years) Helmspersons who are eleven or twelve years of age on July 30, 2017.

Red Fleet (13-15 years) Helmspersons who are thirteen or fourteen or fifteen years of age on July 30, or a sixteen-year-old who has turned sixteen during calendar year 2016.

Green Fleet (5-15 years as of July 30, 2017) The Green fleet is for beginner sailors. No one who has participated in past Red, White Blue Fleet ILYA Championship Optimist Regatta may compete on the Green course. In addition, no one may participate in the Green Fleet if they have previously placed in the Top 5 of previous year's ILYA Green Fleet Championship Optimist Regattas

3.2 The regatta is open to all IOD Class boats whose skipper is a family, regular, youth or life member of the ILYA.

3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing an official entry form available at [www.regattanetwork.com](http://www.regattanetwork.com), online at regatta headquarters or downloading an official entry form at [www.ILYA.org](http://www.ILYA.org) and mailing it with the required fee to the ILYA at P.O. Box 662, East Troy, WI 53120. The entry form is considered part of the NoR even though it is a separate form.

3.4 All entries must be received or postmarked by July 15, 2017 to avoid late penalties. Internet registrations require payment via Visa/MC/Amex/Discover cards.

3.5 Entry is not complete until entrants have signed the entry form and warranted that no changes to the yacht or its equipment have been made since it was last weighed and certified. Entrants who answer in the negative will need to meet with the Technical Committee on-site to gain compliance.

### 4. FEES

4.1 Entry fees include a Regatta T-Shirt. All Fleets - The registration fee is \$70 per Optimist.

4.2 Registration on payments must be postmarked or otherwise received by July 15 to avoid a \$14 late fee. Registration on site is subject to a \$21 late fee.

4.3 The cost for meals and other activities are described in supplemental information available at [www.ilya.com](http://www.ilya.com) or via printed materials available during check-in at the regatta headquarters.

## 5. SCHEDULE

5.1 A maximum of eight races may be sailed .

5.2 The schedule of events is as follows:

**Sunday, July 30, 2017**

**Monday, July 31, 2017**

0900 Competitor's Briefing RWB 0930 Competitor's Briefing Green

1000 1st Warning Signal 1030 1<sup>st</sup> Warning Signal Green

The time of the warning signal for subsequent races will be posted except when races are sailed back-to-back. On the last day of the regatta, no warning signal will be made after 1200 hours if three races have been completed. If fewer than three races have been completed, no warning signal will be made after 1500 hours.

**Tuesday, August 1, 2017**

## 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available before the start of the regatta at [www.ilya.org](http://www.ilya.org), during registration at the regatta site, and on the official bulletin board during the regatta. The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official bulletin board at the club.

## 7. VENUE

Races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Delavan, located in Delavan, WI.

## 8. THE COURSES

The courses will be specified in the sailing instructions. Please be advised a trapezoid course will be included in the sailing instructions.

## 9. SCORING

One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

## 10. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded as follows: Keeper trophies will be awarded to the top fifteen skippers, , top three girl skippers and top five red, white and blue skippers. Keeper trophies will be awarded to the top ten Green fleet racers. Any ILYA perpetual trophies will be awarded per the relevant deed of gift.

## 11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
