Boats without dollies can be accommodated, but it is recommended that each boat have a dolly (concrete parking lot).

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COACHES, PARENTS AND SPECTATORS:

Register at Office for a guest pass to use the pool facilities and snack bar.
Park Cars and Trailers in designated parking areas
Boat ramps will be available for launching and recovering.
For safety no launching during fleet launch and recovery.
All Coach Boats shall register with RC and display CBYRA flags
Coach, Support and Spectator boats should check with Harbor Master for overnight parking spot.

Awards will be given for top three Opti finishers OPTI Red, White, Blue, Laser Radial, and c420 Classes. Overall Opti will also receive awards. Participation awards will be given in all Opti Green fleet sailors
