- Double-handed boats – preregistration online: \$35, day of: \$40

- 9:30am Skippers and Coaches Meetings
- 10:30am Start of First Race (conditions permitting)
- Lunch On water - timing will be race dependent
- Award Ceremony To immediately follow racing

This regatta will be governed by the racing rules of sailing (RRS), US Sailing Rules and MAYRA rules. All boats must have official class numbers displayed on both sides of their sails, US Coast Guard approved lifejackets must be worn by all sailors and all boats are to have 25ft of tow line.

A 3 minute dinghy start sequence will be used. There will be a maximum of 5 races per class, conditions permitting. However, one race constitutes a regatta. Course information and local rules will be provided at Skippers' meeting.

BYC will provide T-Shirts to the first 100 Registrants.
All sailors should bring a refillable water bottle.
