1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) for 2017-2020, the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US SAILING), and this Notice Of Race, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions or any appendices to the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 The organizing authority is the Ocean City Yacht Club, Ocean City, NJ.
- 1.3 The regatta is designated Category C in accordance with RRS Appendix 1, ISAF Regulation 20.

2. Eligibility and Entry

All Opti, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Sunfish and C-420 competitors may enter by completing registration on-line at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/15056>, or, in person at the Ocean City Yacht Club where sailors will register themselves on a laptop provided by the Club.

3. Risk

It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

4. Registration and Fees

Competitors may register by:

- A. On the on-line registration site at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/15056>, or, in person on the day of the regatta, August 9, 2017 between 8:00 – 9:00 AM.
- B. It is highly recommended that registration be completed on-line prior to arriving at OCYC the morning of the regatta.
- C. Fees are: \$30 for Opti, Sunfish, Laser Radial and Laser 4.7 (\$35 after 8 pm on August 9, 2017)
\$40 for C-420's (\$45 after 8 pm on August 9, 2017)

5. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at the time of registration and check-in.

6. Courses and Racing Area

The racing area will be in Great Egg Harbor for Optis, Lasers, C-420's, and Sunfish. The race courses will have separate starts for each class. There may be multiple race courses with multiple classes on each course. These assignments will be posted before the Skippers' Meeting and also announced at the meeting.

7. Scoring

The Low Point scoring system, RRS Appendix A, will apply. One race constitutes a regatta. Final regatta results are part of the Mid-Atlantic Yacht Racing Association's South Jersey Summer Series.

8. Waiver

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers including the Ocean City Yacht Club, the race committee, protest committee, judges or any other associated organization or official will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

9. Safety

US Coast Guard approved life jackets must be on worn at all times on the water. Each boat shall carry safety equipment conforming to government regulations, class rules, and US Sailing, ISAF rules. A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee as soon as possible. All C-420's must be equipped with an approved masthead floatation device to prevent the boat from turning turtle.

10. Prizes -

- Opti Green – participation awards for all
- Opti Red/White/Blue – 1st through 5th place for each individual fleet
- Opti Overall – 1st through 5th place
- Laser 4.7 – 1st through 5th place
- Laser Radial - 1st through 5th place
- C-420 – 1st through 5th place
- Sunfish – 1st through 5th place
