





March 24th, 2018 14th Annual Leukemia Cup Regatta Organized by the IYC Sailing Club

Notice of Race

1. Rules

- **1.1** The Regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Class Rules Charlotte Harbor Fleet 6, except as modified by these instructions.
- 1.2 The 720 penalty will not be used. One 360 turn will be used in lieu.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 Open to all WD Schock Harbor 20 Class (H20) sailboats sailing without spinnakers.
- **2.2** Open to all skippers from any area boating club who are members of Fleet 6 or the National Harbor 20 Class Association.

3. Entry and Fees

- **3.1** The entry fee is a minimum donation of \$75.00. This is a Charity Regatta benefiting **The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society.** One BBQ Bash ticket included with Entry.
- **3.2** Competitors can enter the regatta by delivering or emailing a completed entry form to Regatta Co-Chair Joe Onofrio onofriojoe@gmail.com.
- **3.3** Checks are to be made payable to The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society or abbreviated LLS and delivered no later than the Skipper's meeting on the IYC Pool Deck from 1700-1900 on Friday March 23rd, 2018.

4. Schedule

- **4.1** 1700-1900 Friday March 23rd, 2018, Skipper's meeting, registration, pick up skipper's packet and social on the IYC Pool Deck.
- **4.2** 1000 Saturday March 24th First Warning Signal.
- 4.3 1700 Saturday March 24th. BBQ Bash and awards. Additional Tickets available on entry form.







5. Sailing Instructions

5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be made available at the Skipper's meeting and emailed to all entrants.

6. Venue and Courses

- **6.1** The Start/Finish line will be in the vicinity of Charlotte Harbor Marker#3
- **6.2** Four Races are planned. One Race constitutes a Regatta.
- **6.3** Windward/Leeward races are planned either once, twice or three times around depending on wind speed and time available. No Races started after 1400.

7. Scoring

7.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing will apply. Rule A2 is modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of its race scores, without exclusion. One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta

8. Awards

8.1 Awards will be presented for first, second place and third place at the Annual BBQ Bash on Saturday March 24th at the IYC. The Chairman's Trophy will be awarded to the top fundraising boat.

9. Communications and Safety

- **9.1** All boats must have at least 1 working VHF Radio on board capable of transmitting and receiving on VHF Channel 16 and 71.
- **9.2** The Race Committee and IYC Support Boat will monitor Channel 16 and communicate on Channel 71.

10. Insurance

10.1 Each participant shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000 USD.
