1. RULES

- 1.1 The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) for 2017-2020 will govern the regatta including PHRF San Diego Class Rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 NAVAL PROTECTION ZONE: The Naval Protection Zone is a 500 yard regulated area of water surrounding all US Naval Vessels greater than 100 feet in length. All vessels within 500 yards of a US Naval Vessel greater than 100 feet in length shall operate at the minimum speed necessary to maintain safe course and speed and shall proceed as directed by any official patrol. **NO VESSEL IS ALLOWED WITHIN 100 YARDS OF A LARGE US NAVAL VESSEL.** These zones are permanently in effect. (33 C.F.R. 165.2030).
- 1.3 USCG "Navigation Rules, International-Inland" (www.navcen.uscg.gov/) apply when a vessel that is sailing under the Racing Rules of Sailing Meets a vessel that is not.
- 1.4 Class Rules of PHRF San Diego (www.phrfsandiego.org) will apply. PHRF Buoy ratings will be used for scoring. PHRF Class breaks will be used. PHRF San Diego or PHRF Southern California must issue each boats valid, current certificate. PHRF certificates from other areas will not be accepted.
- 1.5 RRS 44.1 is modified to allow a One-Turn penalty instead of a Two-Turn penalty. Rules set forth in the sailing instructions are to supercede any rules in the RRS.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all members of organizations affiliated with U.S. Sailing.
- 2.2 To be eligible, yachts must have a current Rating Certificate from PHRF San Diego or PHRF Southern California. Exceptions are boats racing as a one design class.
- 2.3 All eligible boats must register on-line at www.coronadoyc.org/racing no later than 5:00 pm Friday August 11, 2017.
- 2.4 Entries after Friday August 11, 2017 will be at the discretion of the race committee.
- 2.5 Identification on Sails must conform to RRS Appendix G.

3. ENTRY FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee for the regatta is \$35.00. This includes three windward/leeward races, complimentary food for skippers and crew, awards and prizes, and a live entertainment.

4. CLASS BREAKS, PENNANTS, and SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1 All PHRF Classes will use PHRF San Diego Class Breaks and fly the pennants 2-8 as appropriate from the boats back stay.
- 4.2 One design fleets may be considered, if requested, and if at least 5 boats sign up to constitute a class.
- 4.3 Sailing instructions will be available on-line at www.coronadoyc.org/racing as of Monday August 7, 2017.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS AND COURSES

- 5.1 The scheduled time of the first warning is 11:55 am.
- 5.2 The races will start and finish in the vicinity of SD 30.
- 5.3 There are 3 races scheduled on a 1 mile windward/leeward course.

6. SCORING

6.1 Three races are scheduled in the regatta. One race is required to be completed to constitute the series.

6.2 Awards will be awarded to the top boats in each class as follows:
