If you do not have a valid YRALIS PHRF Certificate, and do not wish to obtain one, you are welcome and encouraged to race in the Navigator Division, which is an additional Non spinnaker division for any boats, with or without valid YRALIS PHRF Certificates. PHRF Ratings for the Navigator Division will be assigned by the Race Committee. Please register no later than July 21, 2017. **THIS IS A FUNDRAISING REGATTA.** The entry fee is \$60.00. Skippers and crews are encouraged to solicit additional sponsorship for their boat to support St. Vincent's SWIM Fundraiser.

Start/Racing Area:

The racing/starting area will be in the vicinity between "2A" (Black Rock Harbor) and the Bridgeport Channel Entrance, unless otherwise designated by the race committee on VHF channel 68.

Eligibility: Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker boats with a valid PHRF

certificate are eligible. Any boat is eligible to race in the Navigator Division, with or without a valid PHRF Cert.

Race Management: This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The RRS, 2017-2020 and the prescriptions of US Sailing, except as they are changed by the sailing instructions.

Course: The courses may be windward/leeward and/or

triangle variations, or government marks, as described in the Sailing Instructions. Navigator Division may sail different course from the Spinnaker

and Non-Spinnaker division.

Classes: There will be Spinnaker, Non-spinnaker and Navigator divisions and possibly a Hobie Cat division with sufficient number

of entries.

Free Dockage: Captain's Cove Seaport (Black Rock Harbor) has kindly offered free dockage to any boat with a paid entry to

the regatta. Skippers should contact Captain's Cove in advance to make docking arrangements. Phone number is (203) 335-1433 and they monitor VHF channel 18. Fayerweather Yacht Club will provide free dockage for the regatta weekend (Fri, Sat, Sun). FYC monitors VHF 14 and their phone number is (203) 576-6796 (space permitting, raft up may be required). BRYC will also have a limited number of guest moorings available for

the weekend. BRYC monitors VHF 14 and their phone number is (203) 335-0587.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions and Scratch Sheets will be available at the skipper's meeting and from the committee boat

nstructions: prior to the first warning signal and also available on the websites listed below.

Scoring: Time-on-Time scoring system will be used. The race committee, at their discretion, may run more than one

race. If additional races are sailed, combined scores from all races will be used. There will be no throw-outs.

Prizes/Awards: Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place finishers in each division.
