NOTICE OF RACE

Race 5 of the Redondo Beach Series, Race 2 of the Gene Ford "Around the Point" Series

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY and MANAGEMENT: The organizing authorities for this race are Redondo Beach Yacht Club (RBYC) and Shoreline Yacht Club (SYC). The Race Committees of these yacht clubs will jointly manage this race.

1.0 RULES:

1.1 This race shall be governed by the current 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as modified by the Notice of Race and/or the Sailing Instructions.

1.2 Compliance with US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements for coastal racing are recommended, <http://www.ussailing.org/safety/equipment-and-reqyurenebts/>

** In Long Beach Harbor, keep clear of all non-racers and Deep Keel commercial traffic.

2.0 ENTRY: Sailboats of LOA \geq 19' are invited. Competitors may register in advance by completing the Event Registration Form online at Regatta Network. The deadline for registration is 1800, August 10, 2017. Late entries accepted with approval of Race Committee.

2.1 Entry Fee is \$30.00

2.2 CLASSES:

Classes will be established based on entries submitted. There will be (3) PHRF classes Designated, **A**, **B** and **C**.

A minimum of (4) yachts is required to establish a One Design class.

Verified Non-spin offset is optional in all classes. Classes may be combined for competitive reasons.

3.0 COURSE: The start line will be in the area of King Harbor "Y" Mark, First warning will be at 11:30. The finish will be off the stern of the Queen Mary. Handicap distance is 23.8nm.

4.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The sailing instructions will be available on Regatta Network no later than 8/9/17.

For King Harbor marks, please see links to KHYC mark guide on Regatta Network.

Note: they are in deg*min'sec".

5.0 SCORING: Handicap classes will use PHRF- regional **OWC RATINGS**, time on distance.

6.0 HOSPITALITY:

6.1 Friday (RBYC)

Racers who need a slip at RBYC on the race evening Friday 8/11/17 should contact Commodore Ski Tarnosky, e.tarnosky@gmail.com 310-806-2992, with their boat length and beam before noon on Thursday August 10th. On arrival at RBYC, dock keys will be available for a \$20 (refundable) deposit. The \$20 will be refunded on race day upon return of the dock key.

6.1.1 Parking is \$3 for RBYC guests. Mention RBYC to receive the discounted parking rate at the booth.

6.1.2 The bar opens at 1730 and dinner will be available at 1830.

6.2 Saturday (SYC) - There will be a post race awards ceremony at Shoreline Yacht Club at 1830. All racers are welcome to dock overnight at SYC (**reservations required**) please contact, Deb Kelly, boston878@aol.com , (818) 261-2501, to reserve space. Dock Space is limited.

6.2.1 IMPORTANT: The following is required from SYC for slip space:

1. Reciprocal agreement signed
2. Current insurance certificate
3. Current registration or documentation paper
4. Copy of yacht club card and driver's license

6.2.2 SYC will have a full dinner menu available for all racers and guests.

6.2.3 For boats having guests with a vehicle meeting them at SYC, contact Deb Kelly for parking passes. First come, First served.

7.0 PRIZES: Trophies will be awarded among the leaders based on class participation.
