

NOTICE OF RACE-Revised

Commodores Cup #4/Veterans Day Regatta Navy Yacht Club Pensacola Saturday, November 4, 2017

1. RULES

- **1.1.** This regatta will be sailed under the management of the NYCP Race Committee and will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020*(RRS).
- **1.2.** No national prescriptions will apply.

2. CLASSES

Spinnaker and Non-spinnaker classes will be sailed under GYA PHRF handicapping. Each Class must have no less than 3 boats in order to constitute a separate class. A class having more than 6 boats may be subdivided into separate classes if warranted.

3. ENTRY PROCEDURE

- **3.1** Online registration at https://www.regattanetwork.com/html/calendar.php#. Scroll down to the date of the event to find the link to the registration form.
- **3.2** Entry forms will also be available at NYCP, Bayou Grande Marina, NAS Pensacola, during registration on November 4.
- **3.3** On the water registration will not accepted. All registration must be in writing. Boats that have **not registered prior to the warning signal** will be treated as not competing and will not be scored.
- **3.4** Cost of the Regatta will be \$35.00 with proof that the skipper has a current US Sailing membership card and \$40.00 for non-US Sailing members.

4. SCHEDULE

Saturday, November 4

0930-1030 Registration (Coffee and donuts available) NYCP Crow's Nest.

1030 - Skipper's meeting (for those that can't attend, we'll pass all pertinent info on the radio (channel 69) at 1145.

1155 First Warning. Two races may be attempted. One completed race will constitute a regatta.

1600 (approximately) After-Race Party and Trophy presentation at Crow's Nest NAS Pensacola, Bayou Grande Marina, will begin ASAP upon completion of racing. Complimentary Regatta Dogs and will be available in addition to a cash bar.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. The races will be sailed under the current Pensacola Bay General Sailing Instructions including any amendments (Approved for 2017), except as modified by this Notice of Race.

5.2. The sailing instructions will be available at registration. Current sailing instructions are also available online at NYCP website and on Regatta Network.

6. PENALTY SYSTEM

The Scoring Penalty, Rule 44.3, will apply.

7. THE RACE COURSES

The possible race courses that may be sailed are described in the Sailing Instructions. More than one race may be sailed.

8. SCORING

For the Commodore Cup Series, scoring will be by High Point Percentage Scoring System. However, for these races the scoring will be by Low Point System

9. PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded for each Class (1st –3rd) ASAP after racing is concluded at Navy Yacht Club Pensacola. If a class is subdivided, then there will be a trophy for first place overall class winner.

11. NAS PENSACOLA BASE ENTRY PROCEDURES:

To assist with access to the event, **all boats registered must submit a crew list** to NYCP Fleet Captain Ken Pyle, kpyle1968@gmail.com by September 8, 2017, two weeks prior to the Regatta. The attached form shall be filled out with Name, date of birth and driver's license number. (Submission in MS Excel format is preferred)

Driver and all passengers must possess valid identification (best if DOD/Military ID, but not required). If you arrive at the gate and are told you need a sponsor, there should be someone at the gate entrance on the right-hand side of the road to acknowledge and sponsor you onto the base. If no one from the Navy Yacht Club is present - you can call (850) 292-9756 or (850) 384-4575 and someone will be sent to help you gain access.
