## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all Sunfish sailors. Each sailor must be a current paid member of USSCA and/or ISCA.

2.2 WORLD QUALIFIER - This is a USSCA sanctioned event and will qualify two sailors for the 2018 Sunfish Worlds.

### 3 REGISTRATION AND FEES

Registration is on-line only at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/15296>. Entry fee is \$85 for adults and \$75 for juniors. Add \$15 late fee for registrations after October 29. Entry fee will include regatta favor, dinner Saturday evening, breakfast Sunday morning, snacks on the water and after racing Sunday.

Extra meal tickets for Saturday night dinner and/or Sunday breakfast will be available at registration for \$10.

### 4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and may be available online.

### 5 VENUE

The racing area will be on Sarasota Bay north of Sarasota Sailing Squadron.

### 6 COURSES

The courses will include windward/leeward, triangles or any combination of these. The specific course options and their designations will be diagrammed in the sailing instructions.

### 7 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top 5 finishers overall and the first junior.
