

NOTICE OF RACE

LAKE MONROE SAILING ASSOCIATION 2017 SANFORD FALL REGATTA October 7th and 8th, 2017 SANFORD, FLORIDA



VENUE

The regatta will be hosted by the Lake Monroe Sailing Association, and will be held on Lake Monroe in Sanford, Florida. Regatta organizing headquarters is located at the LMSA Clubhouse, 531 N. Palmetto Ave, Sanford FL 32771

A minimum of five races are scheduled for the event. Additional races will be added as conditions permit. One completed race is required to constitute a regatta.

RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

ELIGIIBILITY AND ENTRY

- The regatta is open to all seaworthy sailboats larger than 12 feet.
- Eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration at Regatta Network (<u>http://regattanetwork.com/</u>) or by submitting a hard copy registration form available on the LMSA website (<u>http://www.flalmsa.org/</u>).
- All registrations must be accompanied with payment to be considered valid

CLASSES

- Expected One-Design classes include Sunfish, Lightning, Flying Scot, San Juan 21, Catalina 22, Wayfarer, Laser, and others. Five entries of the same model will be required for a designated One-Design class. One Design classes will be determined by number of early registration entries.
- Other competitors will be assigned to one of several Portsmouth rated classes based on ratings and vessel type.

COURSES

Courses will be contained in the Sailing Instructions. Courses will be windward-leeward (Saturday) and a Trans-Monroe (Sunday). Combined Scoring.

SCORING

The low point scoring system of Appendix A will be used. No races will be excluded.

Slips may be available at Monroe Harbor Marina. Contact the Marina at (407) 322-2910 for information on slips, Request the LMSA Regatta Rate.

ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
