1. RULES

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to only women. No YC membership required. Boats must have a PHRF certificate. There may be a spinnaker and a non spinnaker division.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration found at www.richmondyc.org.
- 2.3 Entry fee will be \$50 per boat and with an additional \$20 if received after Oct.30th.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5. RACING AREA AND COURSES

The racing area will be North and Central San Francisco Bay

COURSE 1 start at RC boat – Klein mark to P – Blossom to P – finish RC boat

COURSE 2 Start at RC boat – Klein mark to P – Blossom to S - RR to S - finish RC boat

COURSE 3 Start at RC boat – Red Rock to P – finish RC boat

COURSE 4 Start at RC boat – Red Rock to P – Blossom to P – Finish RC boat

6. SCORING

One race is scheduled.

7. ARBITRATION

Arbitration will be in effect for protests involving a rule of RRS Part 2.

8. DOCKAGE

8.1 Participants are invited to use RYC guest dock and dry storage facilities for the duration of the regatta. If you wish to extend your stay to the day before and/or the day after, you must coordinate with the harbormaster.

9. COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may use VHF radio to communicate information about time to start and OCS.

10. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to first place of each division. The trophies and complimentary hors d'oeuvres will be held at the RYC bar after the racing on Nov. 4th
