1. **Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing.
2. **Eligibility and Entry:**
 - 2.1. The regatta is open to all Lightnings with a valid measurement certificate issued by the ILCA.
 - 2.2. This is a Southeastern Lightning District (SELD) Circuit Qualifier event.
