



NOTICE OF RACE

DIVISIONS: Open to all boats. Class splits will be determined by number of entrants and will be posted by 1115 at KHYC before Race #1. One-Design classes may be established with a minimum of 5 entries for that class. In addition, a Spinnaker Class may be established with a minimum of 5 entries for that class. Entries in the Spinnaker class will be eligible for trophies in each individual race, but will not be eligible to compete for the Series Perpetual Trophy.

ENTRIES: Entrants shall complete the online entry process at RegattaNetwork.com Registration can be performed at KHYC from 0900 until 1100 on race day. The entry fee is \$20.00, with a \$3 late fee for entries on race day, or \$45.00 for the entire series.

RULES: Only one man and one woman will be allowed on board. Spinnakers and gennakers are not allowed except in the spinnaker class. For non-spinnaker classes, only one headsail may be flown except during a change to a smaller head sail. **NOTE: If you start with a small jib, you CANNOT change up to a larger jib.** There are no restrictions on sail changes for entries in the Spinnaker Class. The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of USSA and by the sailing instructions, as well as applicable class rules. RRS Rule 82 will not apply to this event.

PENALTY SYSTEM: Rule 44.1 is changed so that the two turn penalty is replaced by the one turn penalty. Rule 44.3 will not apply.

COURSES: A Special His N' Hers course chart and sailing instructions will be available at the registration desk at KHYC prior to each race. All Non-Spinnaker classes will sail the same course on each day as determined by race day sailing conditions. The Spinnaker class may be given alternate courses at the discretion of the Race Committee.

STARTS: The warning signal for the first race each day will be at 1255. Subsequent classes will start on signal from the Race Committee boat, usually at 5 minute intervals.

SCORING: PHRF Random Leg (RLC) handicaps will apply to non-spinnaker classes, Buoy handicaps for the spinnaker class. Non-spinnaker offsets will be used for boats sailing without spinnakers. The scoring method will be Time on Time (TOT). Individual classes will be scored separately as a series in accordance with the Low Point system in appendix A 4.1 and A 9 of the Racing Rules to determine class winners. All races shall be scored. The overall series winner will be determined by scoring all non-spinnaker classes together in the same manner as the individual class scoring.

TROPHIES: Both racers on award-winning boats shall receive trophies. Individual class trophies will be awarded after each race on the upper deck of KHYC. Trophies for overall class winners and The MAUREEN CASH MEMORIAL TROPHY for the overall series winner will be awarded at the annual KHYC *Racing Awards Trophy Night*.

FACILITIES: All participants are welcome in the Club before and after the race. Post race hors d'oeuvres will be served. Participating boats are welcome to use the KHYC overnight guest dock and hoist facilities. Call the KHYC Office for inquiries concerning the Guest Dock.
