1. RULES

- 1.1. This series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. The first sentence of RRS 40 is changed so that competitors shall comply with the obligations of RRS 40 (wear a PFD) whether or not the Race Committee displays flag Y with one sound.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 2.1. Notices will be posted on the SCYC Official Notice Board, located in the northeast corner of the SCYC clubhouse, and will be posted on line at the event website.
- 2.2. A Competitors' Meeting will be held at 1000 hours on November 18 at the SCYC Clubhouse.
- 2.3. On the water, the Race Committee may use VHF channel 68 for communication.

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1. Changes to these Sailing Instructions will be posted no later than 1030 hours on the day they take effect, except changes to the schedule of races which will be posted no later than 1800 hours the night before they are to take effect.
- 3.2. Signal flag "L" will be flown from the SCYC clubhouse to indicate changes have been posted.

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 4.1. Signals made ashore will be displayed from the SCYC clubhouse deck.
- 4.2. When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1-minute' is replaced with 'not less than 60 minutes' in race signals AP.

5. SCHEDULES OF RACES

- 5.1. Racing is scheduled for November 18 and December 16 of 2017; and for January 20, February 17 and March 17 of 2018.
- 5.2. The scheduled time of the first warning signal each day is at 1155 hours.
- 5.3. Subsequent races shall be held after the completion of each race.
- 5.4. For subsequent races, Classes may be started in any order.
- 5.5. Fifteen races are scheduled. Three are scheduled each race day. No race will be started after 1600.



Sailing Instructions

Including Change #1 11/8/17

- 7.1. The racing area will be within a three (3) mile radius from the Santa Cruz Harbor.
- 7.2. The Start will be located approximately three quarters of a mile SE of the Santa Cruz Harbor.

8. THE COURSES

- 8.1. Course numbers will be signaled by the display of a numeral pennant on the race committee Signal Boat.
- 8.2. The diagram in Attachment A shows the courses, including the approximate angles between the legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

9. MARKS

- 9.1. Mark W will be an **ORANGE** inflatable Tetrahedron.
- 9.2. Marks Y and L will be <u>YELLOW</u> inflatable Tetrahedron.
- 9.3. Mark "SC7" will be a Yellow Can located at: 36 56.5 N 122 0.98 W
- 9.4. Mark "SC3" will be a Yellow Can located at: 36 56.5 N 121 58.00 W
- 9.5. Mark "Gov" will be White Ball located at: 36 57.46 N 122 0.72 W
- 9.6. Mark "Mile" will be the Safe Water Buoy located at: 36 56.46 N 122 0.57 W
- 9.7. Mark Sp will be a **<u>RED</u>** ball.
- 9.8. Mark SBs will an **ORANGE** flag flown from a flag staff on the signal boat or a **RED** ball if the race committee signal boat is not on station.
- 9.9. The following Marks are Rounding Marks: W, Y, L, SC7, SC3, Gov and Mile.

10. THE START

- 10.1. The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee signal boat and Mark Sp.
- 10.2. Competitors are reminded that RRS 24.1 requires boats whose preparatory signal has not been made (and therefore are not racing) to avoid boats that are racing. Stay clear of the starting area when not racing.
- 10.3. The Race Committee may hail, on VHF, the sail number or any identifying features of any boat that was on course side of the starting line at her start signal. The failure of a hail, the failure of a boat to hear the hail, or the order of the hail(s) shall not be grounds for a boat to request redress. This changes RRS 62.1.

11. THE FINISH

11.1. The finish line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on a race committee Signal Boat (Mark SBs) and Mark Sp. A <u>**RED**</u> ball may replace the Signal boat if the boat is not on station.

12. CHECK OUT

12.1. A boat retiring before finishing a race shall notify the race committee as soon as reasonably possible by radio on channel 68 or by telephone to SCYC (831) 425-0690.

13. PENALTY SYSTEM

13.1.RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.



14. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 14.1. Protest forms are available at the SCYC regatta shed and at the SCYC Clubhouse office. Protests and requests for redress shall be delivered to the race committee at the SCYC regatta shed or to the club staff at the SCYC Clubhouse within the time limit.
- 14.2. The protest filing time limit will be 60 minutes after the arrival of the race committee signal boat at the dock and will be posted on the SCYC Official Notice board.
- 14.3. Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses.

15. SCORING

- 15.1. Three races constitute a series.
- 15.2. When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores. When five or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.


