1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and as modified by the Sailing Instructions.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:
 - 2.1. The regatta is open to all PHRF monohull sailing boats with a minimum length overall of 20 feet.
 - 2.2. All boats must have operational auxiliary power (an engine that works)
- 3. CLASSES:
 - 3.1. Classes will be assigned based on CORA PHRF handicaps. Boats without a CORA PHRF rating will be assigned one. Classes will be posted on the Notice Board after registration and announced over VHF Channel 73
- 4. FEES:
 - 4.1. Early Boat Registration \$45 (through November 4th).
 - 4.2. Late Boat Registration \$55 (Nov. 5th-11th)
- 5. REGISTRATION:
 - 5.1. Registration is available at the Charleston Yacht Club office through November 10, 2017 at 1700PM.
 - 5.2. Onsite registration will be available during the Skippers Meeting on Friday, November 10, 2017 at 1830.
- 6. SCHEDULE:
 - 6.1. Friday, November 10th 1830 SKIPPERS MEETING in ChYC Flag Room, followed by drinks upstairs
 - 6.2. Saturday, November 11th 1225 First Warning Gun
 - 6.3. Saturday, November 11th 1530 to 1800 Trotman Oyster Roast
 - 6.4. Awards Ceremony following racing on ChYC Decks
- 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:
 - 7.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available online and will be available at the Skipper's Meeting on Friday, November 10th at 1830.
- 8. VENUE:
 - 8.1. Hosted at the Charleston Yacht Club (17 Lockwood Drive, Charleston, SC 29401)
 - 8.2. Racing in the Ashley River and Charleston Harbor.
- 9. THE COURSES:

9.1. The courses will be "around fixed Government marks and dropped marks" and will be included in the Sailing Instructions. The Start will be in the Ashley River, in front of the Charleston Yacht Club.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM:

10.1. US Sailing Appendix T1 is in effect.

11. SCORING:

- 11.1. The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 11.2. One race is scheduled.
- 12. AWARDS:
 - 12.1. Awards will be given to the top 3 boats in each class.
