

NOTICE OF RACE Bay Yacht Club Turkey Day Regatta

Invitation: You are cordially invited to participate in the annual BYC Turkey Day Regatta. This regatta is also a scoring component of the regional 2017 Competition Cup series. This race is open to all yachts that file proper entry form and pay the entry fee by 0900 hours on or before November 18th 2017.

Rules: This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) as published by the International Sailing Federation (ISAF) and as amended by the 2013-2016 US Sailing Prescriptions and the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility: The regatta is open to any yacht that holds a current PHRF certificate or provisional rating as applicable from South Texas PHRF or has applied to the BYC Race Chairman for a temporary rating. The Race Chairman may assign a temporary rating to any yacht for the purpose of this regatta and such decision on a yacht's rating is final.

Classes: Classes will be comprised of PHRF ALL SAILS and PHRF NON-SPINNAKER.

Entry Fee/Form: \$30.00 for the regatta. Registration though Regatta Network is encouraged. Registration closes Saturday November 18th at 0900 (Skippers Meeting). Late registration will be accepted on a case by case basis by RC and will incur a \$5.00 late fee. Entrants belonging to CCYC or BYC may charge their fees to their respective clubs. All others must pay though Regatta Network via CC or cash at the skippers meeting.

Registration: Registration via Regatta Network.

Skippers Meeting: Skippers meeting will be conducted November 18, 0900 hours at the BAY YACHT CLUB, on board the upper deck of the Bay Star. Bay Star is berthed at the southern end of the Lawrence Street T Head. Sailing Instructions will be provided NLT November 18th via Regatta Network.

Courses: The course(s) for the race will be marks in the Corpus Christi Bay designated by number on the CC Bay Chart or temporary buoys/marks placed by the race committee. The course for each class will be announced at the Skipper's Meeting.

Races: This Regatta will be held Saturday November 18th. First flag on Saturday will be at **1100**. Starting sequence for all classes Saturday will be announced at the Skipper's Meeting. No start sequence will start after 1500 (3pm). Up to four races scheduled for all classes weather and conditions permitting. One race shall constitute a regatta. Regatta may be rescheduled to Sunday November 19th in case of inclement weather.

Scoring and Trophies: Overall scoring will be low point scoring. There will be no throw outs. The trophy presentation for the regatta will be at approximately 1800 on board the Bay Star the day of the regatta followed by dinner. Dinner is \$7.50 per plate and RSVP to RC required NLT Thursday November 16th. Beer/Wine and Sodas will be provided.
