## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*: Appendix E and the DragonForce 65 Restricted Class Rules.

### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The series is open to DragonForce 65 remote controlled sailboats only.

2.2 An eligible boat may enter by submitting the online entry form together with the appropriate fee at:

2.3 All boats must be properly registered online in order to compete.

### 3 FEES

The fee for the series is: \$30.00.

### 4 SCHEDULE

4.1 Onsite check-in will take place for the first 30 minutes on each race day.

4.2 In the event of too much ice in the harbor, that race day will be rescheduled.

## **5 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Sailing Instructions will be available no later than the Wednesday before the first event and will be posted online.

## **6 RACING AREA**

The racing area will be Belmont Harbor near/around the Chicago Yacht Club - Belmont Barge or in front of Chicago Yacht Club - Monroe Station.

## **7 COACHING**

- 7.1 Chicago Yacht Club may provide on the water coaching during the racing. This changes rule 41.
- 7.2 A competitor shall not seek redress for failure to receive specific coaching instruction or as the result of the consequences of a particular coaching instruction. This changes rule 62.1(a).

## **8 SCORING**

- 8.1 Six races will constitute a series.
- 8.2 Once a series has been completed, each boat may exclude her worst scores, one race for every 7 sailed, rounding up, for the entire series.

## **9 PRIZES**

- 9.1 Daily Awards: Boat of the Day
- 9.2 Series Awards: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd overall
