

One Design Midwinter's Sarasota Sailing Squadron Supplemental Sailing Instructions March 16-18, 2018

1. Schedule of Races

Date	Number of Races	First Warning Signal
Friday, Mar 16	4	1130
Saturday, Mar 17	4	1100
Sunday, Mar 18	4 (Note1)	1030

Note 1. No new races to start after 1400 on Sunday.

2. Race Management

- 2.1 The race office is located inside the club house in the manager's office.
- 2.2 A temporary flag pole is located on the southeast side of the club.

3. Marks and Class Flags

- 3.1 In the event of the next leg change of the course, Mark 1a will not be relocated. All classes shall round the new Mark 1 leaving it to port.
- 3.2 If only one gate mark is set, boats shall leave the single mark to port.
- 3.3 Marks and Class Flags are described in Attachment 1.

4. Racing Areas

The racing areas are depicted in Attachment 2.

5. The Start

5.1 The Race Committee may announce the sail number or boat name of any premature starter on the applicable VHF channel. Failure to make an announcement or the order in which boats are announced shall not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

6. Time Limits

4.1	Race Time Limit	60 Minutes
4.2	Finish Window	15 Minutes

7. Scoring

- 6.1 For the Windmill Class, 3 races are required to constitute a sanctioned Midwinter Championship.
- 6.2 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 6.3 When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total ofher race scores excluding her worst score.
