1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing including Appendix B, Windsurfing Competition Rules*.
- 1.2 Rule 42 will apply to Konas. This changes rule B4.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.
- 1.4 Appendix P applies to this event.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in between the shop and the bathrooms.

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day it will take effect, except to the extent that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 1800 on the day before it will take effect.

5. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flag pole.

5.3 When the fleet is onshore class flag up on the flagpole indicates 30 minutes until next warning for that class.

6. PROPULSION

6.1. Rule 42 will apply to the Kona Class from the removal of the preparatory signal at one minute.

7. The Finish

7.1 The finishing line will be between a committee boat flying an Orange Flag and the finishing mark. The time limit for the first board to sail the course and finish 40 minutes.

7.2 Boards finishing 20 minutes will be scored TLE or finished in place.

8. Scoring and excluded races

8.1. All divisions will have separate starts.

8.2 When fewer than 5 races have been scored no scores shall be excluded.

8.3 When 5 races have been scored a boat's worst score shall be excluded.

9. Minimum number of races; time limits

9.1. A minimum of 1 race shall be completed to constitute a regatta.

10. The Start

10.1 Starting Sequence will be 5 minutes as described in RRS rule 26

10.2 Kona class flag will be the "K" flag, Techno class flag will be the "T" flag, Raceboard class flag will be "W" Silver Fleet will be "green flame" flag.

10.3 For images of class flags see Appendix B.

11. Racing area

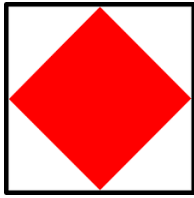
11.1. The racing area shall be on the east side of Clearwater Harbor.

12. Courses

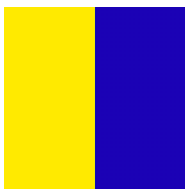
12.1. If a mark is shown as gate, the gate may be replaced by single marks. If a gate is replaced by a single mark it is to be left to port.

12.2 Courses will be designated by course boards W2, W3, W4

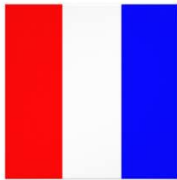

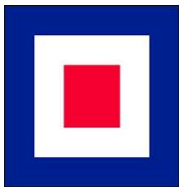
F Flag - Formula
