**1. RULES**

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing including Appendix B, Windsurfing Competition Rules.*

1.2 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

1.3 Appendix P applies to this event.

**2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS**

2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in between the shop and the bathrooms.

**3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

3.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day it will take effect, except to the extent that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 1800 on the day before it will take effect.

**4. SCHEDULE OF RACES**

## **5. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE**

5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flag pole.

5.2 The class flag for Formula will be the “F” flag, class flag for Techno class will be the “T” flag, class flag for Windfoil will be the “7” flag.

5.3 When the fleet is onshore class flag up on the flagpole indicates 30 minutes until next warning for that class.

## **6. The Finish**

6.1 The finishing line will be between a committee boat flying an Orange Flag and the finishing mark.

6.2 The time limit for the first board to sail the course and finish is 40 minutes. Boards finishing 20 minutes after the leader will be scored TLE or finished in place.

## **7. Scoring and excluded races**

7.1. All divisions will have separate starts.

7.2 When fewer than 5 races have been scored no scores shall be excluded.

7.3 When 5 races have been scored a boat’s worst score shall be excluded.

## **8. Minimum number of races; time limits**

8.1. A minimum of 1 race shall be completed to constitute a regatta.

## **9. The Start**

9.1 Starting Sequence will be 5 minutes as described in RRS rule 26

9.2 The class flag for Formula will be the “F” flag, class flag for Techno class will be the “T” flag, class flag for Windfoil will be the “7” flag.

9.3 For images of class flags see Appendix B.

## **10. Racing area**

10.1 The racing area shall be in the Gulf of Mexico, west of the Sheraton Sand Key Resort.

## **11. Courses**

11.1 Courses are in Appendix A.

11.2 If a mark is shown as gate, the gate may be replaced by single marks. If a gate is replaced by a single mark it is to be left to port.

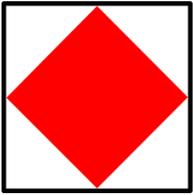
11.3 The starting boat will have a standoff buoy off her stern. This is part of the starting boat.

11.4 Courses will be designated by course boards W2, W4, WG2, WG4

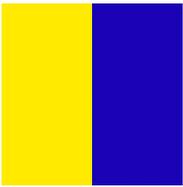
## **12. Wind Minimums**

12.1 In the event the leaders of a race are unable to plane or foil for 5 minutes, Race Committee will abandon the race.

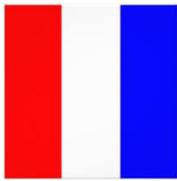

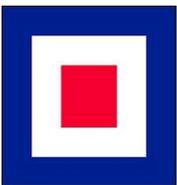
F Flag - Formula

W Flag - Raceboard

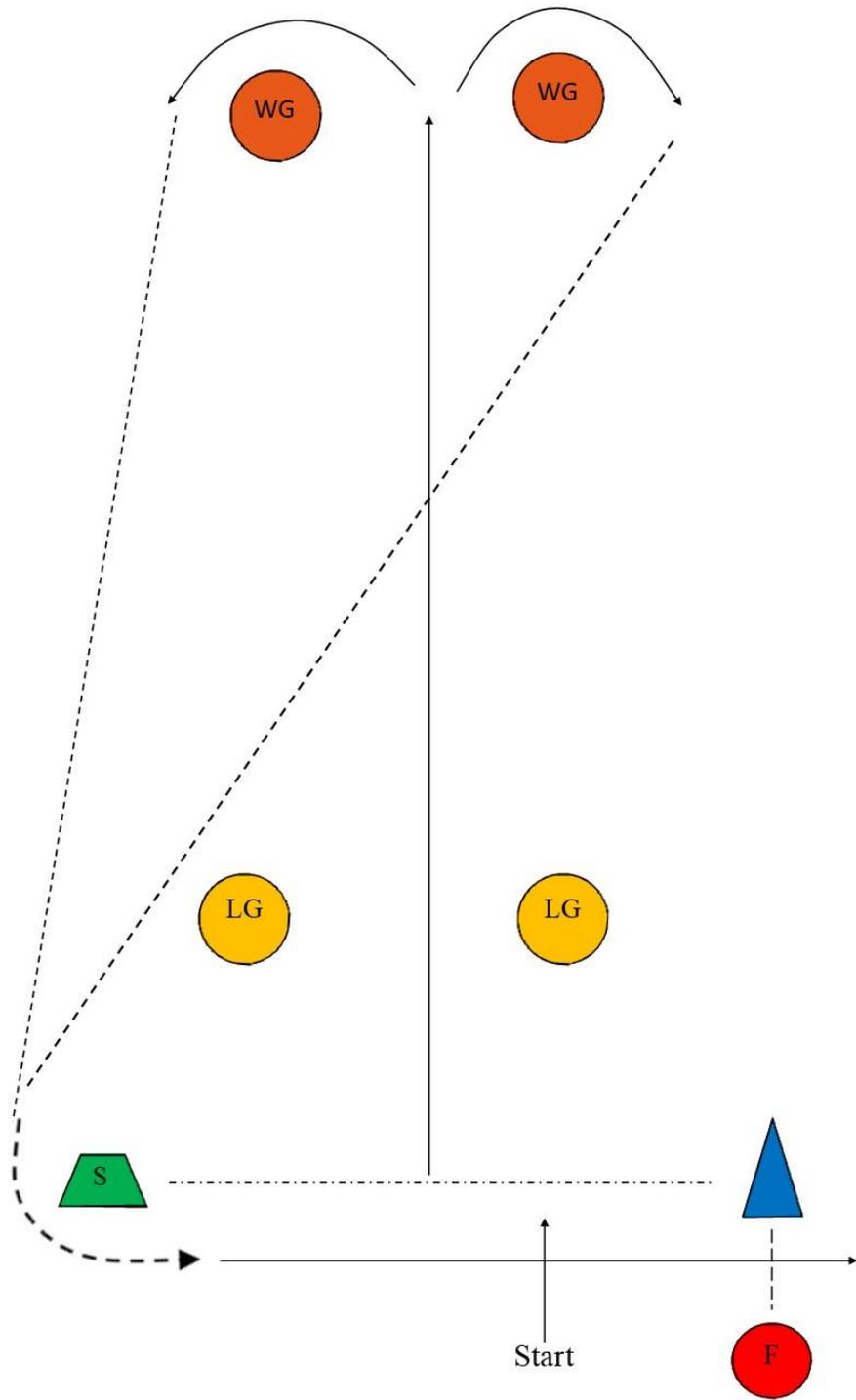


7 Flag - Windfoil

Course WG2

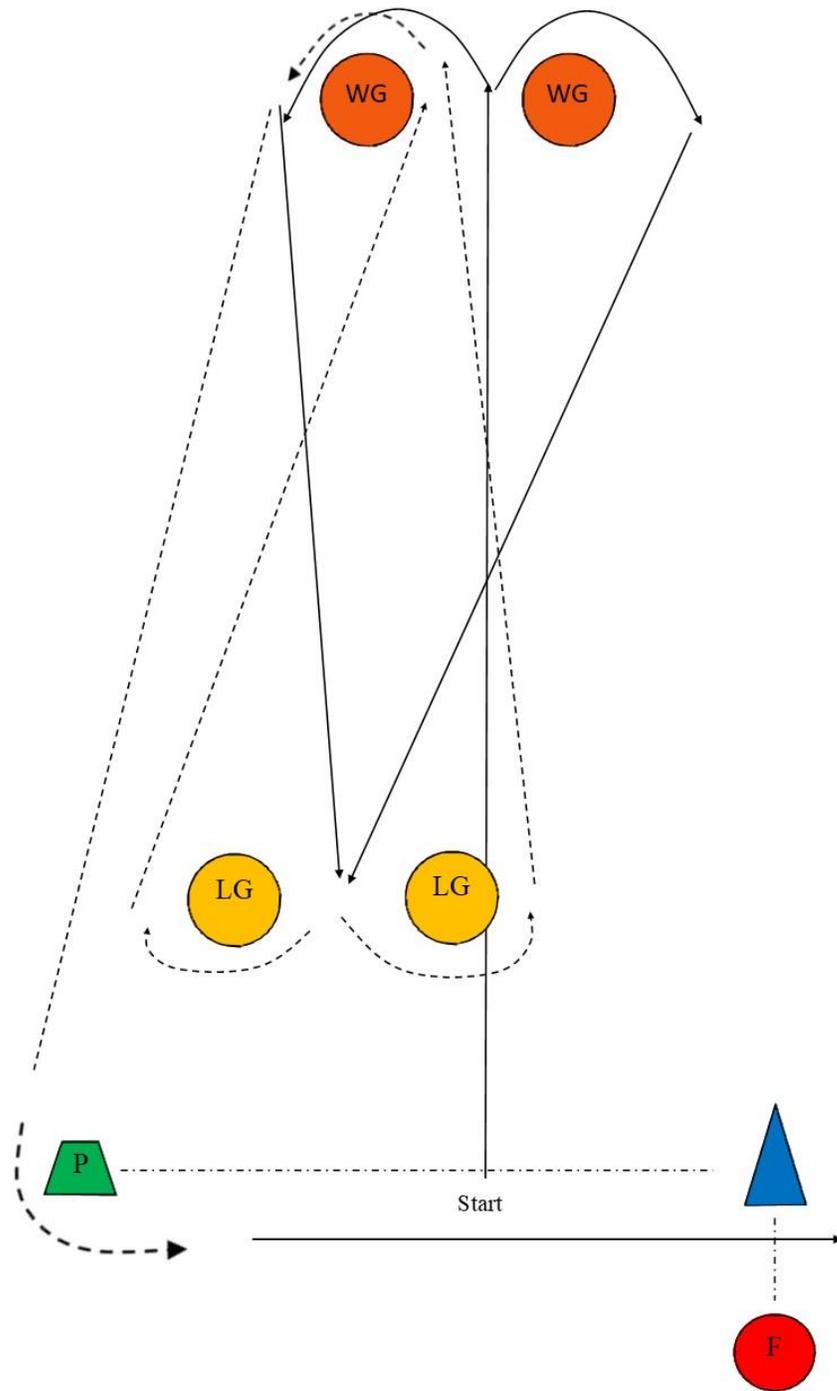
Start, Windward Gate

Course WG4

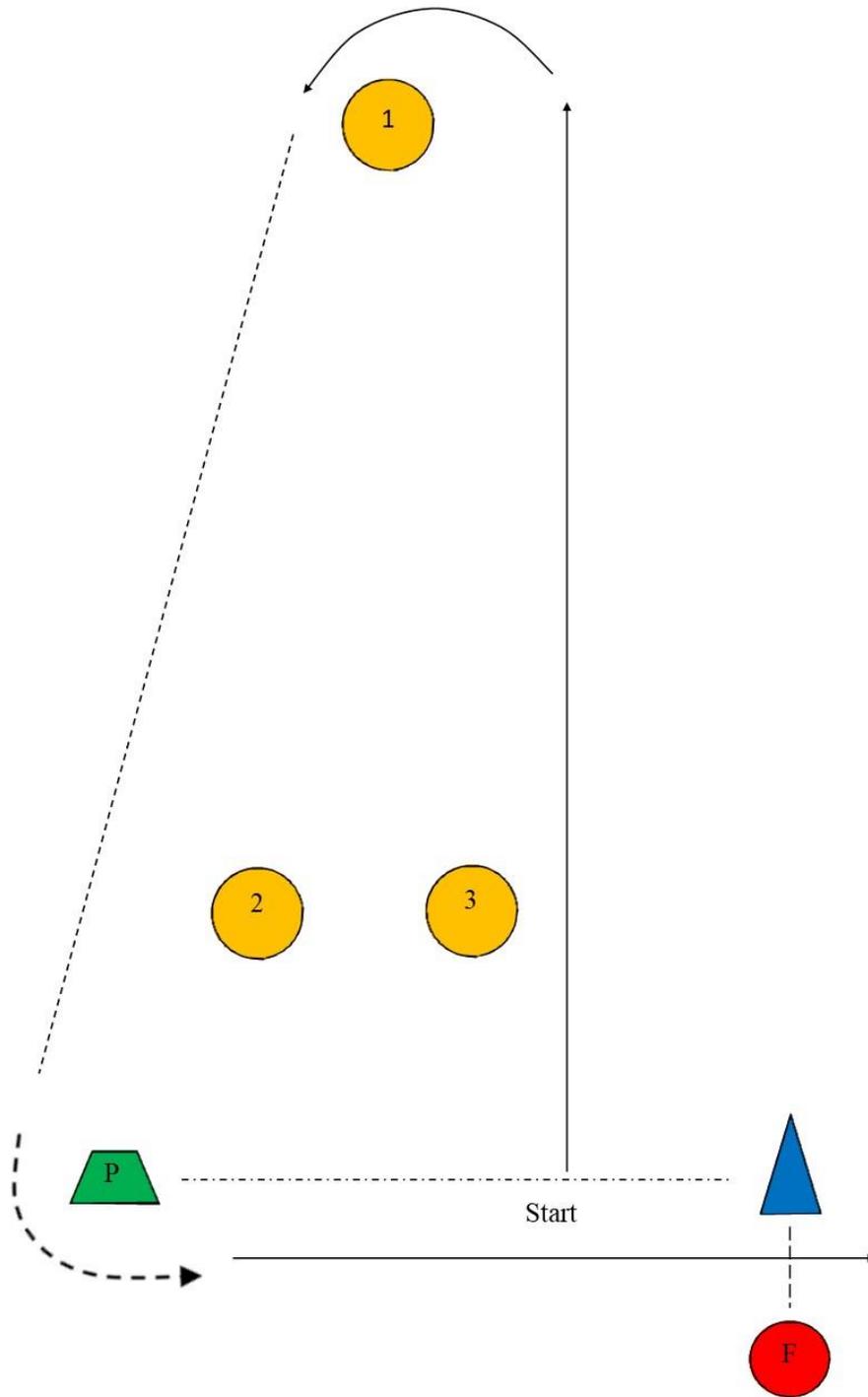
Start, Windward Gate, Leeward Gate,
