1. RULES

- 1.1 The event shall be governed by:
- 1.1.1 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing Windsurf Competition Rules.
- 1.1.2 Formula Class Rules for Formula Class.
- 1.1.3 The Kona Class Rules for Kona Class.
- 1.1.4 The RSX Class Rules for RSX Class.
- 1.1.5 The Techno Class Rules For the Techno.
- 1.1.6 Th RS One Convertible for the RS One Convertible
- 1.1.6 If there is a conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing instructions will take precedence.
- 1.1.7 No national authority prescriptions will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- 2.1 A Minimum of 5 competitors is required to constitute a division. Those entries accepted that do not constitute a division may sail another division as defined by the race committee.
- 2.2 Classes eligible for entry include:
- 2.2.1 Formula, Kona, Longboard, RSX, Techno, Open Wind Foil, and RS One Foil.

3. Divisions

- 3.1 The participating classes and divisions will be:
- 3.1.1 Formula Class Men, Women,
- 3.1.2 Kona Class Men, Women, Youth 18 and Under
- 3.1.3 Longboard Class Men, Women
- 3.1.4 RSX Class Men, Women
- 3.1.5 Techo Class

4. FEES

4.1 The entry fee for adult competitors is \$140 USD if received by February 23rd a late fee \$15 USD will be added for entries after February 23rd.

- 4.2 The entry fee for youth(under 21) competitors will be \$125 USD if received by February 23th and a late fee of \$15 USD will be added for entries received after February 23rd.
- 4.3 Late registration will be available onsite March 8 from 1600 to 1900.
- 4.4 Fee includes three lunches, two dinners, and a t-shirt.

7. MEASUREMENT

7.1 It is the responsibility of each competitor that his /her board and equipment conforms to the class rules.

8. VENUE

- 8.1 The regatta will be held at the Clearwater Community Sailing Center, Clearwater FL.
- 8.2 Racing will take place on the waters of Clearwater Harbor east of the sailing center and in the Gulf of Mexico East of Sheraton Sand Key.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 One races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 9.2(a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a board's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When 5 to 11 races have been completed, a board's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When 12 races have been completed, a board's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

10. PRIZES

10.1 Awards will be given to 1-3 for each division over 10 boards. In divisions with less than ten boards only first place will be awarded.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
